5. Do I believe in the necessity of foreign missions? Will I champion it in my church among my spheres of influence through inviting missionaries to speak and helping with events that support missions?
6. Do I feel supportive of the organization's senior leadership?
7. Is my spouse supportive of my serving this board?
8. Why should I not serve?
9. Do I sense God's leading in this decision?
10. Do you have the blessing of your pastor and elders for this position?
