MINUTES OF THE CANADIAN PRESBYTERY, ARPC STATED JANUARY MEETING – JANUARY 21, 2006

Teleconference Meeting

The Stated January Meeting of the Canadian Presbytery was held on January 21, 2006 by teleconference. Nineteen (19) presbyters were in attendance for this meeting of presbytery.

Presbytery Convenes for Stated January Teleconference Meeting

At 9:05 a.m. (E.S.T.), the Vice-moderator, Rev. Frank Kovacs, called the presbyters to order and convened the 2006 Stated January Teleconference Meeting of the Canadian Presbytery. Rev. The plan is to have an arrangement in which the Canadian Presbytery shall be the church court that issues the call to Mr. de Vries, and in which Cornerstone Bible Institute shall provide the finances to sustain this call. The proposed terms for the call are being drawn up at this time.
