Changes to the Rules of Procedure placed on the docket from the March meeting were considered.

CHANGES TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE

Changes to the Rules of Procedure placed on the docket from the March Meeting are as follows:

1. Presbytery accepted The Procedure to Dissolve a Congregation presented at the last March meeting. A motion was made as follows: "That the Procedure for Dissolving a Congregation be added to the Rules of Procedure as policy Article XI and the current Articles XI and XII be re-numbered."

Change number 1 was ADOPTED.

2. Change E: State of the Church, Section 1, amending e) by adding: "The Committee may also initiate contact with a church that obviously needs help."

Change number 2 was ADOPTED.

The report of the Judicial Commission appointed to act in behalf of Presbytery was presented and RECEIVED AS INFORMATION as follows:

REPORT OF THE JUDICIAL COMMISSION

The Commission on the Minister and his Work reported to the Presbytery at the October 11, 2011 Stated Meeting:

"A member of Presbytery has contacted the Commission concerning his actions over a long period of time. The member of Presbytery has confessed his actions, is repentant of those actions, is presently in counseling, and seeks forgiveness and reconciliation. The charge against him is the breaking of ordination vow number 6: "Do you sincerely resolve to fulfill all your responsibilities in your home life and in all your relations with your fellowman, following after righteousness, faith, and love?" (Form of Government, Chapter X, D. 2. g 6. p.212).

From the Book of Discipline we learn, "The basis of all church discipline is the free love of God in Christ expressed in both mercy and judgment. The purpose of discipline is to bring

the reconciliation of man to God and man to man and to engage the people of God in the ministry of reconciliation, and to promote the peace, purity, and edification of the Church.”

Few people know of the offense. The Book of Discipline, Chapter 5, A, 7 states, “Before proceeding with any judicial process, the court, or a committee appointed by the court, should seek by private conference with the accused to avoid, if possible, the need for actual judicial process.” Also Chapter 5, A, 8 states, “If the offender confesses, the way is clear for the court either to restore him or to impose such censure as the welfare of the offender and /or the Church may require.”

The Commission feels that the proper way of handling the charge against the brother is by private means. We believe that it would be best for the Church, Presbytery, and the brother’s family if this is done by the Commission” (Minutes 2011-12 volume I, Page 30, Stated Meeting, October 11, 2011, Bethel ARP Church).

During the October 11 meeting of Presbytery, the following recommendation with respect to the report above was approved: “Recommendation 9. That the Commission on the Minister and his Work be elected as a Judicial Commission, to act on behalf of Presbytery in a Judicial Case against a member of Presbytery, in order for it to be handled privately” (Minutes 2011-12 volume I, Page 30, Stated Meeting, October 11, 2011, Bethel ARP Church).

Since the Fall Meeting of Presbytery, the Commission has labored for reconciliation in the member’s marriage. We have met with him and his wife, prayed for them, and remained in contact with this member of Presbytery on about a weekly basis through the Chairman. The disposition of the Judicial Commission was to do all we could to support this member of Presbytery and his wife in the process of your re-establishing the covenant of their marriage.

At the Stated Spring Meeting, March 12, 2012 at the Centennial ARP Church, The Judicial Commission reported: “The Commission has met twice with this member of Presbytery and has made a careful and thorough investigation into his breaking ordination vow 6. The Commission has maintained communication with this member on almost a weekly basis. The member has continued to repent of his sin and is seeking to make appropriate restitution and reconciliation with the parties involved. The member and his wife are receiving regular biblical counseling. The Commission has sought to provide appropriate support to the member’s wife. The Commission has issued a temporary suspension to this member of Presbytery which disallows the practice of any of the duties associated with the office of Minister. The Commission plans to continue working with this member of Presbytery and will report to Presbytery action and progress related to this judicial case.”

The Judicial Commission sent written notice to this member of Presbytery to meet with the Judicial Commission on March 1. He indicated he would meet with us, but failed to show. He called a few minutes prior to the meeting and said he would send an email explaining why he was not meeting with us. The email revealed his plan to intentionally disregard his covenant in marriage through adultery and abandonment of his wife and marriage. These actions gave grave concern to the Judicial Commission.

While the goal of church discipline is restorative and not punitive, we learn in the Scriptures that there are consequences to our sin(s). Moreover, a lack of repentance curtails restoration.

The Judicial Commission sent written notice dated April 19 to meet with this member of Presbytery on Thursday, April 26 for a Judicial Trial. The Judicial Commission of Catawba Presbytery met Thursday, April 26 to convene a judicial trial with respect to the items which Presbytery charged us to investigate and handle as a Judicial Commission on Presbytery’s behalf.

Again this member of Presbytery failed to show at the trial. In his absence, the Judicial Commission appointed one of its members to serve as Counsel to ensure that each step of the ARP Book of Discipline was followed to confirm a just and properly ordered procedure.

The charges against this member of Presbytery were twofold: the breaking of ordination vow number 6 (as outlined above), and failure to keep the vows of the covenant of marriage.

After a careful review of the facts of the case and investigation process, the Judicial Commission examined the evidence presented including the member's own testimony of wrongdoing. The Judicial Commission acting on behalf of Presbytery in its full authority by a unanimous vote found this member, John H. Hopkins, guilty of both charges.

This member in an email dated, March 1, 2012, requested to be removed from the roll of Presbytery. The Judicial Commission again acting on behalf of Presbytery by a unanimous vote made the following decisions: (1) That John H. Hopkins is Deposed from the Office of a Minister of the Gospel; (2) That he is Removed from the Roll of Catawba Presbytery with Censure; (3). That his Ordination is Revoked, and (4) That he is Suspended from the Lord's Table.

The Judicial Commission takes no pleasure in the actions that the decisions of Mr. Hopkins have required us to make. We grieve over his sin and continue to pray for him and his relationship with the Lord. Moreover, we also are praying for his family and desire that he repent and his marriage be restored according to God's purpose. The Commission has maintained appropriate contact with his wife.

A certified letter was mailed to Mr. Hopkins dated April 30, 2012 explaining the decisions of the Judicial Commission and the reminder of a two week period of appeal of this verdict and resulting status with the Presbytery to the next higher court. The signature of the return receipt of the reception of the letter by Mr. Hopkins was dated Friday, May 4, 2012. The two week period of appeal terminated Saturday, May 19, 2012. The Principal Clerk of Synod and the Stated Clerk of our Presbytery were consulted and no appeal was received by the deadline.

Recommendations:

1. That this report be received by Presbytery and printed in the minutes.
2. That the Presbytery remember this situation in prayer and that the Judicial Commission be dissolved.

- A letter was received from First Columbia regarding property they will purchase. There will be no liens on the property.
- At the direction of the Chairman of the Commission Philip R. McCoy was transferred to First Presbytery effective June 30, 2012. Mr. McCoy will become pastor of First Statesville.
- At the direction of the Chairman of the Commission Matthew T. Mantooth was transferred to First Presbytery effective July 15, 2012. Mr. Mantooth will become an Associate at the Back Creek Church.

2. That the plans of First Columbia be endorsed.

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK

The Commission met with student Jonatan Simons to review his written exam for licensure and ordination and administer his oral exam. The Commission voted to present him to the Presbytery for his Licensure sermon and an oral exam on the floor of Presbytery.

The Commission also met with Chester H. Lanious, a retired Army Chaplin and member of an Orthodox Presbyterian Church Presbytery. He is residing in the bounds of Catawba Presbytery and is interested in transferring into Catawba Presbytery.

Recommendations:

**SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT OF THE
COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK:**

The Sharon Session presented Mr. Gill Martin, a recent RTS graduate, to serve as their interim supply. The Commission examined him for serving as a supply.

Rev. Phil McCoy has requested to dissolve the pastoral relationship with the Rowan ARP Congregation effective June 30, 2012 in order to respond to a call to serve as Pastor of the First Statesville congregation of First Presbytery. The congregation at a congregational meeting approved the dissolution.

Rev. Matt Mantooth has requested to dissolve the pastoral relationship with the Neely's Creek ARP congregation in order to respond to a call to serve as Associate Pastor of the Back Creek congregation of First Presbytery effective, July 15, 2012.

Rev. Peter Rambo has requested to dissolve the pastoral relationship with the New Hope ARP congregation effective May 27, 2012. The congregation at a congregational meeting approved the dissolution.

Additional Recommendations:

4. That Gill Martin be approved to serve as the interim supply of the Sharon ARP congregation
5. That the pastoral relationship between Mr. Phil McCoy and the Rowan ARP Church be dissolved effective June 30, 2012.
6. That the pastoral relationship between Mr. Matt Mantooth and the Neely's Creek ARP congregation be dissolved effective July 15, 2012.
7. That the pastoral relationship between Mr. Peter Rambo and the New Hope ARP Congregation be dissolved effective May 27, 2012.
8. That Mackey Smith be examined for a transfer exam, and if the way be clear, the call from Oak Ridge be read, approved and presented to Mr. Smith, and that a service of ordination and installation be arranged through the Chairman of the Commission.
9. That the senior sermon of Jonatan Simons be received by the Presbytery as a specimen of progress and that Mr. Simons be examined for licensure.
10. If the way be clear, that the call from the Clover Congregation to Mr. Simons to serve as Associate Pastor be read, approved, and presented to him and that a service of ordination and installation be arranged through the Chairman of the Commission on Sunday, July 29, 2012.

Recommendations 1 and 8 were presented and ADOPTED. Mr. Lauten conducted the transfer examination for Mr. Smith and Mr. Lanious. The examinations were SUSTAINED. Mr. Lanious was enrolled in the Presbytery by transfer from Central US Presbytery, OPC and Mr. Smith was enrolled as a licentiate by transfer from First Presbytery. The enrollments are effective today.

Recommendation 2 was approved.

The terms of the Call from the Oak Ridge Church for David Mackey Smith to serve as pastor was read and Approved as follows with terms to begin July 1, 2012:

1. When a housing allowance is provided, it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide :
 - a) Total Compensation of \$41,500:
 - b) Base Salary \$27,500
 - c) Housing allowance \$11,000
 - d) Travel Allowance \$3,000
2. Pay your moving expenses
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Provide 100% of Synod's life, and health, and dental insurance package for the pastor and his family.

5. The Church provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death Coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.
6. One weeks to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
12. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

The call was approved and will be presented at the time of ordination.

Recommendation 3 was approved. Mr. Simons was examined. The examination was SUSTAINED.

The Service of Licensure was conducted by the Moderator. Mr. Simons received a Certificate of Licensure.

Recommendation 9 was ADOPTED.

The Call from the Clover Church for Mr. Jonatan M. Simons to serve as Associate Pastor OF Youth and Family was read and approved with terms to begin on August 1, 2012: as follows

1. When a housing allowance is provided, it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide :
 - 1) Total Compensation of \$34,600:
 - a) Base Salary \$18,000
 - b) Housing allowance \$13,000
 - c) Travel Allowance \$3,600
2. Pay your moving expenses
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Provide 100% of Synod's life, and health, and dental insurance package for the pastor and his family.
5. The Committee on Church Extension provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death Coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.
6. One weeks to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.

11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
12. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

The call will be presented at the time of ordination

David H. Lauten, Chairman of the Commission, read a letter received from Paul Bell, Director of Central Services and the Board of Benefits informing the Presbytery of the arrears payments of \$82,000 for insurance premiums owed by the Rogers Memorial congregation for Synod's Insurance.

After discussion, a motion was made and ADOPTED that the Commission on the Minister and His Work be appointed to act in behalf of Presbytery to resolve his situation.

The Stated Clerk, Guy H. Smith, announced the Fall Meeting for October 9, 2012 at the Chester Church, Chester, SC beginning at 10:00 a.m.

The Moderator introduced the new Moderator Michael S. Evans, elder from Arsenal Hill. Mr. Evans begins his term July 1, 2012.

Mr. Fleming then introduced the new Vice Moderator, J. Barry Dagenhart pastor of First Rock Hill Church. Mr. Dagenhart will become moderator on July 1, 2013.

Words of thanks were expressed to the retiring moderator, Billy O. Fleming, for his faithful and dedicated service during the past year.

Following the singing of Bible Songs 280, "Christian Unity" Presbytery recessed to adjourn with the adjournment of Synod. The Moderator, Billy O. Fleming closed the meeting with prayer and benediction. The Presbytery adjourned on Thursday, June 7, 2012 with the meeting of Synod.
