At the last meeting, the Clerk was directed to write the Sessions of Faith Fellowship and Hope, TX to remind them to bring Session records to the March meeting since they had not been brought in over a year to be examined. The records Faith Fellowship were brought to the meeting but the Hope, TX Church failed to bring their session records. The Chairman of the State of the Church Committee Martin Taylor will contact the Hope Church.

New business was considered.

The report of the Stated Clerk/Administrator was presented and ADOPTED as follows;

REPORT OF THE STATED CLERK/ADMINISTRATOR

Information:

1. As Presbytery approved, the Sessions of Faith Fellowship and Hope, TX were written and reminded to bring their Session records to the next meeting of Presbytery.
2. A Commission of the Presbytery consisting of Teaching Elders Clyde T. McCants, Chairman, Clint Davis and Mark Miller along with Ruling Elders Charles Walden {Shiloh}, Robert Patrick {White Oak} and John Taylor {Chester} conducted the Installation Service on December 2, 2012 for James McManus as pastor of the Bethel Church. The sermon was delivered by Rev. David Hall.
3. Reports from the various churches were received. The portion concerning salaries was referred to the Commission and matters relating to congregations were referred to the Committee on State of the Church.
4. It was noted in the reports that Scot's Kirk is not keeping rolls of Marriages and Deaths as required in the Form of Government.
5. It was noted in the reports that New Hope has only 1 elder and is not meeting at present.
6. Our Presbytery has always prided itself in attendance of our ruling elders at Synod and Presbytery meetings. According to the annual reports and confirmed by the Presbytery roll we have 5 churches that were not represented by ruling elders at meetings of the Synod or Presbytery during 2012. We also had several other churches who attended on only one of those meetings in 2012. This information was given to the State of the Church Committee.
7. The information on Denomination Ministry pledges for 2013 was forwarded to the Committee on Commitment and Finance
8. At the direction of the Chairman of the Commission a transfer was issued to Second Presbytery for licentiate D. Mackay Smith to be effective March 12, 2013.
9. Recently one of our Presbyteries found it necessary to rely on a liability policy that covers their Presbytery. Since we are now handling property, continue to sponsor a number of retreats each year and often are involved in personnel matters, it may be advisable for our Presbytery to research whether or not we should obtain liability coverage for the Presbytery.

Recommendations:

1. That a letter be written to the Scot's Kirk Session reminding them that the Form of Government requires keeping rolls of Marriages and Deaths as part of the Session records.

2. That the Committee on Commitment and Finance study the need for liability insurance for the Presbytery and make recommendations to the June meeting of Presbytery.
3. That the report be received as information and included in the Minutes.
4. That the compilation of the reports from the churches be approved for submission to General Synod. [APPENDIX C]

The report of the Committee on Christian Education was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Catawba Presbytery's Christian Education Committee met at 7:00 pm on January 28, 2013 via conference call. The following statistical data was received as information and passed on to you for the same purpose.

- **Fall Middle School Retreat** – 13 churches from Catawba Presbytery participated with an attendance numbered at 201.

Your Committee also received, reviewed, and approved the following plans from the planning teams of the upcoming spring retreats and passes them on to the Presbytery for approval.

- **Spring Middle School Retreat** – The spring retreat for Middle School students is scheduled for March 22-24, 2013 at Bonclarken. The theme will be "Jesus as Our Justification-Sanctification-Glorification." Rev. James McManus, Pastor at Bethel ARP Church, Winnsboro, will be the keynote speaker, while Evan and Scott Frazier will lead the music.
- **Spring High School Retreat** – The spring retreat for High School students is scheduled for March 1-3, 2013. Rev. Philip Bunch, Associate Pastor at First ARP Church Rock Hill, will be the keynote speaker. The Erskine Barn Band will lead the students in worship.
- **Adult Retreat** – The Adult Retreat is scheduled for May 2, 2013 at Ebenezer ARP Church in Rock Hill. The retreat's theme is "On a Biblical View of Human Life." Dr. Bob Cara of the Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC will be the keynote speaker. Several seminars on the retreat's theme will be offered in the afternoon as a part of the program.
- **Children's Retreat** – The Children's Retreat is scheduled for April 6, 2013 at Tirzah ARP Church, Rock Hill. The retreat's theme will be "Resurrection Island" Donna Thomas will lead in worship and various other volunteers will teach the students on the grand theme of the gospel.

The report of the Committee on Church Extension was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION

The Committee met on January 28, 2013, at First Presbyterian Church, in Columbia. We received reports from all our current mission works. Brandon Barrett reported on the Grace mission, Andy Stager reported on the Hill City mission, David Stover reported on our newest mission in Rock Hill, and we received a written report from David Winburne, at King's Parish in Dallas, TX.

The provisional session from the Grace mission was invited to participate in their update. A request followed which was made to the Committee to begin proceedings toward organization of their congregation.

The Committee found their report acceptable and approved the request from Grace Mission toward organization in accord with our Rules of Procedure to complete the organization.

We have this recommendation:

1. That the Grace Mission become organized as a congregation and that the steps outlined in the Rules of Procedure be followed to complete the organization.

The report of the Commission on the Old Brick Church was presented and RECEIVED AS INFORMATION as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF THE OLD BRICK CHURCH (OBC)

Since its last report to Presbytery the Commission met on 24 January 2013 in order to discuss several items of business and reports the following activity:

Items:

- After recent inspections of the church building and grounds, the Commission reports that several large stones have toppled from the central back (south) wall of the cemetery, that the door jambs for both the north and west doors need to be replaced, and that three window panes need to be replaced. In addition, the Commission received comparative costs for repair and installation of the granite steps at the west door of the church versus the purchase of wooden moveable steps to overlay the current steps. After considerable discussion the Commission concurred that the condition of the steps posed a liability issue and that a permanent solution was needed. The estimated cost of these repairs totals \$4725 as follows: wall (\$1100); door and window repairs (\$775); and side door steps repair (\$2850). A unanimous vote was approved for this work.
- The Commission discussed plans for a work day to be held on 28 March 2013 from the hours of 10-2 to include lunch. The primary focus of the work day will be cleaning tombstones for the entire cemetery. Mr. Lever and Mr. Harwell suggested that a memorandum be sent to Rev. Guy Smith for circulation to churches in Catawba Presbytery to seek volunteers for this effort. In addition to cleaning tombstones, Mr. McMeekin commented on the need to cut back undergrowth and spray herbicide as needed in the area beyond the cemetery wall and volunteered to provide equipment for this purpose.
- The Commission discussed initial planning for a worship service to be held at the OBC on the afternoon of Reformation Sunday, 27 October 2013. Mr. McKown distributed planning documents from previous services. Items of discussion included personnel, publicity, music, equipment, and logistics.
- Other items of discussion focused on finances, publicity and outreach.

With time remaining before the order of the day, the Moderator called on Mr. Lauten to introduce the student. Mr. Lauten introduced Brooks D. Presbytery continued with new business considering portions of the report of the Commission on the Minister and His Work.

The report of the Commission on the Minister and His Work was presented as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK

The Commission reviewed the laboring out of bounds requests and pulpit supply requests. The Commission is still waiting for a laboring out of bounds request from Denny Hieber that has not been submitted. The Commission is also following-up with a request related to Peter Rambo. A recommendation on these out of bound situations will be provided in a supplemental packet.

The Commission is also still waiting for a Pulpit Supply request from the New Hope Session. A recommendation on this Supply Request will be provided in a supplemental packet.

David Rowe has requested to be honorably retired effective March 31, 2013. The Blacksburg congregation has consented to Rev. Rowe's request.

The Commission met with the Provisional Session and leaders of the IBL work and interviewed Efrain Valladares to serve as the Interim Supply of the IBL work.

The Commission met with Daniel Wells a member of Hill City Mission and an Erskine College and Reformed Theological Seminary graduate. He is currently a licentiate of Florida Presbytery and is requesting to come Under Care of Catawba Presbytery as a Student of Theology.

The Commission met with Students of Theology Brooks Willet and Mark Witte for their written and oral exam for licensure and ordination.

Information

Vacant Churches: At the present time the Presbytery has 12 Vacant Churches, with 4 actively searching for a new Pastor. SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT: COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK

The Commission received the laboring out of bounds request of Denny Hieber.

The New Hope Session is requesting Presbytery to approve Rev. Jerry Wolff to serve as supply.

The Commission reviewed the compensation of members of the Presbytery and found them to be within the guidelines of the Presbytery.

The Commission met with a Peter Rambo, a member of Presbytery currently without a charge, who has reported a change in his theological views. Over a year ago, Mr. Rambo indicated that he had objections to the celebration of Christmas and Easter. The Commission is aware that these concerns have been shared by many of our forefathers. However, in November, Peter has expressed a more significant change in his views. The Commission asked Mr. Rambo if his change in views would lead to taking exceptions to the ARP Standards, and in particular, the Westminster Confession of Faith. Mr. Rambo has outlined his primary exceptions to the ARP Standards as the denial of Sunday as the day of worship with a view of Saturday as the proper day of worship; an obligation of Christians to keep the Old Testament dietary laws;

an obligation of Christians to keep the Old Testament feasts, and an exception of lesser importance is the wearing of tzitzit (tassels worn around the waist). The Commission has met with Mr. Rambo on two occasions, but nothing could be provided to dissuade Mr. Rambo from his theological exceptions. Mr. Rambo requests to be released of his ordination and relation with the Presbytery on theological grounds of incompatible and irreconcilable differences with the ARP standards. Mr. Rambo is now worshiping with a Messianic Congregation in Prosperity, SC and involved with Messianic congregations in Greenwood and Laurens.

The Book of Discipline in chapter VIII, Withdrawals, states in section 2, "If a minister notifies the presbytery that he can no longer adhere to the standards of the Church due to a change in his doctrinal views, the presbytery shall endeavor to resolve his difficulties. Upon failure to resolve, the presbytery shall grant the minister a certificate indicating his relationship to the presbytery, stating reasons for his separation from the presbytery, enter the facts on the record, and remove the minister's name from the roll." The Presbytery Rules of Procedure in Appendix H: "Exceptions to the Standards of the General Synod, A Procedure of Catawba Presbytery, speaks in sections 2 and 3, "**Section 2:** If an individual takes an exception to the Standards, the Commission will ask for the Biblical and theological grounds upon which the exception is held and in what circumstances and manner the exception would be taught. **Section 3:** The Commission on the Minister and His Work shall inform the Presbytery as part of its written report: A] The exception, citing the exact reference in the Standards; B] The Biblical and theological grounds on which the exception is held; and C] Its recommendation on whether or not the exception may be taught." While Appendix H is primarily focused with candidates seeking membership in the Presbytery (section 1), the Commission is following the basic procedure of communication of exceptions to the ARP standards as outlined there. In keeping with these guidelines, the Commission includes a lengthy nine page statement of Mr. Rambo's exception to the ARP Standards. The Commission neither concurs with these exceptions nor affirms they should be taught.

Recommendations from the Commission:

9. That Denny Hieber be approved for laboring out of bounds for one year beginning April 1, 2013.
10. That the supply arrangement of the New Hope Session with Jerry Wolff be approved for a year beginning April 1, 2013.
11. That the review of the calls of the Ministers as submitted by the congregations be approved.
12. That in keeping with the Book of Discipline, Chapter VIII, and Mr. Peter G. Rambo's request to be released from his ordination and relation with the Presbytery, be it moved that Mr. Rambo be removed from the roll of Presbytery effective today entering the facts of his grave theological exceptions on the record, and that the Presbytery Clerk communicate the removal of his ordination and a summary of his exceptions to Presbytery Clerks across the Synod and that he not teach or be asked to teach in ARP congregations.
13. That Justin D. Brickey be presented as a student of theology and if the way is clear that a Service of Recognition be officiated by the Moderator and his name be added to the roll of Students of Theology.
14. That the call from World Witness to Mark Witte be read and approved, and if the way is clear, that the details of his ordination be arranged with the Chairman of the Commission and the call presented to him at that time.

Presbytery recessed for lunch at 12:00 p.m. The blessing was given by Evan B. English, host pastor.

Presbytery re-convened at 1:00 p.m. at the call of the Moderator. Mr. Lauten introduced Brad D. Anderson to preach his Middler sermon. Mr. Anderson used as his scripture Colossians 2:1-15. The Moderator thanked him for his message.

New business was continued as scheduled

The report of the Committee on State of the Church was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE STATE OF THE CHURCH

The Committee met the day of Presbytery to examine session records from churches whose names begin with the letters A-H along with the records of Faith Fellowship, Hope, TX, IBL Mission, First Lancaster, Lemira, Living Waters, New Hope, Providence, Rock Hill Parenting Mission, Rogers Memorial and Westminster who did not bring records to the last meeting. After examining the records according to the guidelines from the Rules of Procedure, the Committee makes the following recommendations:

1. That the records of the following churches be approved without exception: Bethany, Calhoun, Centennial, Chester, Clover, First Columbia, Edgemoor, Edwards Memorial, Faith, Good shepherd, Hickory Grove, Hopewell, First Lancaster, Living Waters, Rock Hill Parenting Community Mission

Recommendation 14 was ADOPTED.

The call from World Witness for Mr. Witte to begin his work effective March 12, 2013 was read and APPROVED with the following terms:

1. Basic compensation:
 - a. When a manse is provided:
 - i. Base Salary \$30,559.45
 - ii. Plus a cost of living allowance based on Efficient Purpose Index differentials for Spain.
 - iii. Provide you with housing in Spain as needed for your family and in accordance with World Witness housing policies for expatriates
 - iv. Travel expenses reimbursed in accordance with World Witness travel policies for expatriates.
2. Pay your moving expenses in accordance with World Witness policies
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan Fund as prescribed by the General Synod.
4. Pay 100% of your coverage in Synod's life, dependent life, accidental death and dismemberment and disability plans.
5. Pay 100% of your family's coverage in the World Witness Cigna International Health, dental and evacuation insurance plan for expatriates.
6. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 to 6 weeks.
7. Provide according to Board approved annual budget as it relates to the World Witness Manual and Missionary Handbook.

The call will be presented to Mr. Witte at the time of his ordination.

Martin Taylor, Chairman of Church Extension, moved that the name of the Rock Hill Parenting Community Mission be officially changed to River Crossing, ARP. The motion was ADOPTED.

The Stated Clerk, Guy H. Smith, announced the June meeting June 11, 2013 at the Bonclarken Chapel beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Announcements were made.

Following the singing of Bible Songs 280, "Christian Unity" Presbytery adjourned prayer and the benediction given by J. Allen Derrick.

Around 190 women attended for a wonderful time of renewal centered on a study of Proverbs, which will be the ARP women's study focus for the coming year. I'm pleased to say that we offered a 50% discount to wives of pastors, which was greatly appreciated by those attending.

Although some women missed the retreat we have another opportunity to gather at our "Meet and Greet" at First ARP Lancaster on June 1. Please encourage your women to attend to learn more about church planting in Catawba Presbytery and ONA.

In conclusion, in many different settings women of all ages throughout Catawba Presbytery gather regularly for Bible study and prayer, service in a variety of ways, and outreach. They desire to be fruitful and faithful and appreciate the prayers and encouragement of their pastors and elders. May we together as men and women continue to work jointly for Christ's glory and purpose.
