Catawba Presbytery met at the Edwards Memorial Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church, Cayce, SC on October 13, 2015 for its Stated Meeting beginning at 10:00 a.m. Moderator Alan A. Morrow called the meeting to order and gave a scriptural call to worship. The opening hymn was "A Mighty Fortress is Our God". The Moderator then constituted the meeting with prayer.

The roll was constituted by Guy H Smith from the signed enrollment cards. A quorum was present. The Moderator welcomed visitors and encouraged them to register.

Recommendation 1 from the Commission report was presented and ADOPTED. {See page 22} Mr. Blake Law was examined for transfer from First Presbytery as a licentiate. Mr. Rogers asked the questions. Following the examination, the Commission asked for Executive Session. The motion was APPROVED by a standing vote of 36-35.

Presbytery re-convened and a motion was made and ADOPTED that Mr. Law be received as a licentiate from First Presbytery effective today.

Recommendation 2 concerning his ordination and approval of his call was ADOPTED. {See page 22}. The Moderator asked the questions from the Form of Government. All questions were answered in the affirmative. Members of Presbytery came forward for the prayer of ordination offered by Kyle E. Sims. The right hand of fellowship was extended to Mr. Law and he was presented his Certificate of Ordination.

The call for Mr. Law from the Calhoun Church was read and APPROVED. The Moderator presented the call to Mr. Law and it was accepted as follows:

The Call from the Calhoun Church for Blake T. Law to serve as Pastor to begin on October 15, 2015 included the following terms:

1. When a housing allowance is provided it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide:
  - 1) Basic Compensation: \$40,000
    - Base Salary \$20,500
    - Housing Allowance \$18,000
    - Travel Allowance – \$1,500
2. Pay your moving expenses
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Provide 100% of Synod's life, and health, and dental insurance package for the pastor and his family.

5. The Church provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death coverage provided by and required by General Synod. **(Required if works 30 hours per week or more)**
6. One week to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the Board shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. Book or Software Allowance - \$200
12. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
  - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
13. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
  - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

The Service of Installation by a Commission of the Presbytery will be October 16, 2015 at the Calhoun Church.

Presbytery moved to the order of the day for a student sermon.

Kyle E. Sims, a member of the Commission, introduced Andrew Di Iulio to preach his Middler sermon. Mr. Di Iulio used as his scripture Matthew 18:21-35. The Moderator thanked him for his message.

There was no unfinished business.

New business was considered.

The report of the Committee on Commitment and Finance was present and discussed as follows:

### **REPORT OF COMMITMENT AND FINANCE COMMITTEE**

The Commitment and Finance Committee met on August 18, 2015 for the purpose of preparing a proposed budget for fiscal year 2016 and to consider a matter referred by the Clerk/Administrator.

The proposed budget for 2016 is based on income being received from the latest number of members within the Presbytery of 8,632 persons with \$34,528 being proposed for Presbytery expenses, \$4,316 for the Old Brick Church gravestone renovation project, (\$0.50 per member for a period of five years for this was approved at the Spring Meeting) and \$73,372 for Church Extension work.

The Clerk/Administrator received correspondence from Mr. Walter Hogg, an elder in the Mayesville ARP Church who attended one of the Church Finance seminars sponsored by Synod's Board of Stewardship in cooperation with the Board of Christian Education. Mr. Hogg was desirous of sharing some of the information presented at the seminar with the churches of Presbytery. Mr. Smith referred Mr. Hogg's request to the Commitment and Finance Committee. After due consideration, the committee requested that Mr. Smith contact the staff of Administrative Services and if the way was clear, considering copy write considerations, that this information be distributed amongst our congregations. The way was found to be clear and the distribution was accomplished on August 19.

The Committee was also advised that the audit of the Treasurer's books is scheduled to be completed and presented at this meeting.

The Committee is thankful to our congregations for submitting their annual commitments of \$13 per member in a timely fashion, which affords our being able to financially support the work of Presbytery. We are also thankful to God that we continue to have several church extension works in place and that funds are available to support these efforts.

Our thanks are also extended to Mr. Lever for the fine work he has done and is doing as Treasurer of Catawba Presbytery.

Recommendations:

1. That the proposed budget for 2016 be approved.
2. That each session be mindful of the required review of their Treasurer's books at least every three years.
3. That action of the Committee in reference to Mr. Hoag's recommendation be sustained.
4. That Jim McLurkin be thanked for his years of service as chairman.

The order of the day was called at 12:15 p.m. Following instructions for the meal, the blessed was given by Melvin M. Wines.

Presbytery re-convened at 1:15 p.m. and discussion resumed on Recommendation 1. An amendment was offered by Clint Davis and APPROVED by a voice vote that the budget be amended by making the 2016 Presbytery Assessment be \$15 per member instead of \$13 and that the additional money go to the work of Church Extension.

A second amendment was offered by Guy H. Smith that the Committee on Church Extension provide the Treasurer with a line item usage for the extra money. The amendment was ADOPTED.

Recommendation 1 was ADOPTED AS AMENDED.

Recommendation 2, 3 and 4 were ADOPTED.

The report of the Committee on Christian Education was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

**REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHRISTIAN EDUCATION**

The Catawba Presbytery Christian Education Committee met on Monday, August 24<sup>th</sup>, at Chester ARP Church. The following is a **summary** of that meeting.

**Reports of past events:**

- **Spring High School Retreat** – The retreat was held at Bonclarken on March 6-8, 2015. 28 churches from 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and Catawba Presbyteries participated (12 churches from Catawba) with a total of 275 participants. The retreat theme was *The Trinity* with Brad Anderson of First ARP Columbia as the speaker. Worship was led by Meager Fare.
- **Spring Middle School Retreat** – The retreat was held at Bonclarken on March 27-29, 2015. Dave Hall was the speaker and Andrew and James’ *Hillbilly Jugband Extraordinaire* led the worship music. 14 churches participated with a total of 176 participants.

**Reports of planned events:**

- **Fall High School Retreat** – The retreat will be held at Bonclarken on September 25-17, 2015. The theme will be *The Things You Can Be Sure Of* and the speaker will be Mark Iler of New Albany ARP. Music will be led by Andrew Di Iulio of First ARP Columbia.
- **Fall Middle School Retreat** – The retreat will be held at Bonclarken on November 6-8, 2015. The speaker will be Matt Mantooth of Back Creek ARP. Music TBA
- **Children’s Retreat (2015)** – Retreat is planned for Saturday, November 14, 10am-2pm at Tirzah ARP. Theme is based on Ephesians 6:11 – “Putting on the Full Armor of God.” Joy Feemster of Neely’s Creek will be the teacher and Jamie Dagenhart will lead music.
- **Spiritual Life Conference (2015)** – The Spiritual Life Conference will be held on Sunday, September 20, 3:30pm-5:30pm at First ARP Rock Hill. The theme will be evangelism/apologetics with Hank Hanegraaf of the Christian Research Institute and host of the “Bible Answer Man” as the speaker. This conference is for all ages.

**Other Actions:**

- Mark Herring, who serves as the moderator for the IBL church, gave an update report to the committee on the current status of the IBL Mission
  - Justin Brickey has resigned as pastor to pursue mission work in Spain
  - Rev. Nilo Rios is currently filling the pulpit in a stated supply role on a month-to-month basis
  - Congregation has been asked by the Provincial Session to consider him for an extended role
  - Rev. Rios is interested in expanding his role to include more pastoral duties
  - Financially the congregation is paying bills but not much beyond
  - Future Provisional Session Activity
    - Session is planning on having a joint meeting with the congregation at its next congregational meeting
    - Session will continue to oversee the ministry of Rev. Rios
    - Session will provide leadership training
- Update on Hispanic Leadership Initiative (HLI)
  - HLI is an initiative of the PCA in Texas (<http://www.hlipca.com/>); Park Cities Presbyterian Church's page for the HLI - <http://pcpc.org/global-local/hispanic-leadership-initiative/>
  - After several failed attempts at reaching out to HLI, we are now in a position to send several delegates to their fall conference (we are working on a list of potential participants)
- Other initiatives
  - We are continuing to explore and discuss how we need to respond to the rapidly changing demographics in our nation; one example is that 1 in 3 US citizens will be Hispanic within 30 years

The report of the Commission on the Old Brick Church was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

### **REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF OLD BRICK CHURCH (OBC)**

The Commission has met on two occasions since its last report to Presbytery: 16 May 2015 and 20 August 2015. The Commission reports the following activity and makes two financial requests.

#### **Items:**

The Commissioners conducted a meeting and a clean-up of the grounds on 16 May 2015. The effort inside the graveyard wall concentrated on trimming shrubs, applying weed killer, and treating some fire-ant mounds. Outside the wall we removed dead-fall and bush-hogged the periphery on the east, south, and west portions of the property.

The Commission approved the Fletcher Monuments' proposal to continue gravestone stabilization and repair. Work will be conducted in the September/October 2015 time-frame with 25 markers to receive attention. The Commission had previously approved in January 2015 an amount of \$4,500 for this work.

At the 16 May 2015 meeting the Commission approved \$475 for the installation of "rail-road-ballast-size" granite rock along the roof's drip-line. Some washing and erosion had occurred in some areas along the building's foundation. This fix is working to good effect,

Coordination continues with the Fairfield County Museum (FFCM)/Historical Society (FFCHS) to identify living descendants of families interred in the graveyard for the purpose of building a support network of those descendants. On 16 May 2015 the FFCHS recognized the OBC Commission with the William Banks Patrick Historical Preservation Award. The recognition included a \$200 cash award.

The Commission welcomed Mr. Andy Chandler of First Presbyterian Church, Columbia, as a new Commission member at the 16 May 2015 meeting. We also extend a warm welcome to Rev. Alan Morrow, Moderator of Presbytery, as the newest Commission member. The Commission looks forward to Rev. Morrow's guidance over the next year. Please keep Rev. Morrow and his family in prayer as they recover from a home invasion.

Two building maintenance issues need address: (1) Since the DP3 Architects' "Ebenezer ARP Old Brick Church Assessment and Stabilization Report" completed in 2009, the Commission has monitored a problem of some deteriorated mortar joints on the exterior walls and foundation. Further aging, compounded by bore holes in some of the mortar joints caused by bee activity, has become a concern which warrants correction as soon as feasible. Delay will only worsen the problem and lead to increased repair costs. A brick mason inspected the concerned areas on 20 August 2015 and will re-point the problem mortar joints for \$2,500. (2) The Commission has discovered some deteriorated roof decking immediately under the eaves on the south-side of the building. In several places this has created space between the top row of the wall's soldier bricks and the decking which invites varmint intrusion. Evidence exists in the balcony inside the building of possible squirrel or bat activity. A contractor inspected the problem on 6 September 2015 and recommends a run of trim adjacent to the top row of soldier bricks and the roof's decking to close all gaps. The trim would be painted to match the fascia. This repair will cost \$700.

**Recommendations:**

- 1 That this report be received as information.
- 2 That Presbytery approve \$2,500 for the repair of mortar joints on the building.
- 3 That Presbytery approve \$700 to add a run of trim along the top of the south-side exterior wall adjacent to the top row of soldier bricks and the roof's decking and paint the trim.

The Commission met with Blake T. Law for a transfer exam from First Presbytery. The Commission interviewed Mr. Law as a candidate for pastor of the Calhoun ARP Church of Calhoun, Louisiana. The Commission interviewed the pulpit search committee of Calhoun ARP Church via phone conference. Heiko Burklin resigned as pastor of Neely's Creek ARP Church effective July 31, 2015. Mr. Burklin is now an employee with World Witness. Andy Putnam was named as the interim moderator of the Neely's Creek ARP Church. Boyce Wilson was named co- interim- moderator of the Smyrna/Hickory Grove churches

**Recommendations:**

1. That Blake T. Law be examined to transfer from First Presbytery(ARPC) to Catawba Presbytery (ARPC) and if the way be clear that he be added to the roll of licentiates of Catawba Presbytery and ordained at today's meeting
2. That the call for Blake T. Law from Calhoun ARPC be read for approval by the Presbytery and if the way is clear be presented to him
3. That the call for Heiko Burklin from World Witness be read as information.

1. When a housing allowance is provided it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide:
  - 1) Basic Compensation: \$70,000  
Base Salary \$50,000  
Housing Allowance \$20,000  
Travel Allowance – all expenses covered
2. Pay your moving expenses up to \$5,000
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Provide 100% of Synod's life, and health, and dental insurance package for the pastor and his family.
5. The Board provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death Coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.
6. One week to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the Board shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
  - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
12. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
  - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

#### **SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON MINISTER AND HIS WORK**

The Commission on Minister and His Work met on Tuesday, September 22, 2015 at 6 p.m. at First Presbyterian Church of Columbia. The Commission met with Joseph Crump for his licensure exam. It was noted that Michael Lashley has resigned from Arsenal Hill ARPC effective December 31, 2015. David Lauten will be the moderator of the Arsenal Hill session effective January 1, 2016. The Commission will begin effective January 2016 using a Middler Bible exam to measure the progress of the students under care of Catawba Presbytery. After discussion, the Commission decided to ask the Presbytery to go into executive session after each student and transfer exam for the purpose of open and free discussion.

Recommendations:

4. That Joseph Crump be presented to the Presbytery for examination for Licensure and ordination and that if his exam is sustained that he be asked the questions for licensure and if the way be clear he be presented a certificate of licensure and his name be added as a licentiate of Presbytery.

5. That Joshua Thomas be presented as student of theology and if the way is clear that the Service of Recognition be officiated by the Moderator and that his name be added to the roll of Presbytery.
