Words of thanks and appreciation were expressed to Treasurer T. C. S. Lever, Jr. for his dedicated and committed service as Treasurer of Presbytery beginning July 1, 1998 and continuing until today. In recognition of his retirement he was presented a Certificate of Appreciation and given a rising vote of appreciation. A gift in Mr. Lever's honor was given to Bonclarken. Brian Howard offered prayer for the service of Mr. Lever and the transition of treasurers.

The report of the Committee on Church Extension was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION

The Committee on Church Extension met on Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at Chester ARP Church in Chester, SC. The committee met with two men about potential new works of gospel ministry for Presbytery. The first was Scott Andes with RUF International at the University of South Carolina, and the second was Josh Walker in Phoenix, AZ. The committee is encouraged by both opportunities for Presbytery to advance Christ's kingdom.

Scott Andes presented a plan for him to be called as a Campus Minister with Reformed University Fellowship International (RUFI) to the committee. Scott will work with international students, most of whom are post-graduate, under the banner of RUFI but will remain an ARP minister. Synod's Committee on College Ministry will provide oversight to Scott's ministry as

students, most of whom are post-graduate, under the banner of RUFI but will remain an ARP minister. Synod's Committee on College Ministry will provide oversight to Scott's ministry as prescribed in the working arrangement that the ARPC has with RUF. In this arrangement, Presbytery will call Scott as a Campus minister; however, it will not be responsible for meeting the financial terms of his call. Scott will be responsible for raising 100% of the financial support necessary to fund this ministry.

Josh Walker met with the committee via conference call to discuss the possibility of presbytery partnering with him for a yearlong church planting internship in Phoenix, AZ. Currently, Josh is a high school Bible teacher and member of the Church of the Redeemer in Mesa, AZ, where he lives with his wife Krystle and their son Calvin. Josh has been assessed by ONA's Church Planting Assessment Center and has been recommended as a candidate for church planting provided he complete a yearlong internship. His current employment and church affiliation lends itself well to the fulfillment of this requirement, as does his city. Phoenix is a city of 5 million people with half of them unchurched. It is one of the 10 most unreached cities with the gospel in America. The committee is excited about the possibility of partnering with Josh and his family in an internship that could possibly lead to an ARP congregation in such a strategically important city. The internship will cost \$12,000 plus traveling expenses for Josh to attend the meetings of Presbytery and Synod and be supervised jointly by the Chairman of the Committee on Church Extension and Dr. Gray Johnson, pastor of the Church of the Redeemer in Mesa, AZ.

Recommendations:

- That Presbytery call Rev. Scott Andes as Campus Minister for Reformed University Fellowship International at the University of South Carolina in Columbia, SC.
- That Presbytery contract with Josh Walker for a yearlong church planting internship in Phoenix, AZ under the supervision of Dr. Gary Johnson at the cost of \$12,000 plus travelling expenses for the meetings of Presbytery and Synod.
- 3. That Presbytery pause to pray for its mission works, church planters, Scott and Victoria Andes, and Josh and Krystle Walker.
- That the name of the Irmo Mission be officially named as King's Church Mission, Associate Reformed Presbyterian Synod.

CATAWBA PRESBYTERY MEMORIAL

Whereas in the providence of God, Catawba Presbytery has an opportunity to invest itself in Gospel ministry among international college students in Columbia, SC, at the University of South Carolina and has agreed to call a minister to develop a campus ministry focused on evangelism and discipleship, and

Whereas the ARP Synod has witnessed its sister denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA), invested in campus ministry for many years in the form of Reformed University Ministries (RUM), and

Whereas the PCA has experienced significant spiritual and numerical growth from such a faithful and Gospel ministry, and

Whereas RUM has agreed to partner with the ARP in a campus ministry to internationals at the University of South Carolina (RUFI) directly affiliated with RUM as are the RUF chapters at Erskine College and Queens University, and

Whereas the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church has established a committee of Synod to oversee the faithful and successful ministries of the RUF chapters at Erskine College and Queens University, and

Whereas the Committee on Campus Ministry Oversight is best suited to coordinate and oversee existing and future campus ministries.

Therefore, be it resolved that Catawba Presbytery memorializes Synod to direct its Committee on Campus Ministry Oversight to oversee a new Gospel work known as RUFI University of South Carolina at the University of South Carolina in Columbia, SC.

Prayer was offered by Garison Taylor for the missions of our Presbytery and their work.

The report of the Commission on the Old Brick Church was presented and RECEIVED AS INFORMATION as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF OLD BRICK CHURCH (OBC)

INFORMATION as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF OLD BRICK CHURCH (OBC)

The Commission met on one occasion, 9 February 2017, since its last report to Presbytery. The Commission has scheduled its next meeting for 11 May 2017 at the Old Brick Church in Fairfield County, South Carolina.

Items:

The 9 February 2017 meeting centered upon a report concerning how we might achieve some ventilation in the building to help retard mildew. The contractor opined that any measures undertaken would involve the copper roof and recommended against any work. He feared that any intended corrective action might end-up causing a greater problem. Consequently, the Commission unanimously agreed to take no action. Additionally, the Commission received a report regarding the stability of the graveyard wall, especially the south-side/back wall. Three separate contractors/excavators had inspected the wall. All three share the same concern. As one would excavate and remove stumps and dirt, the combination of ground and root disturbance would likely cause some wall collapse. Their unanimous consensus was to cut all trees in proximity to the wall and kill all the stumps in-place. Then continue to deal with any wall collapses as they might occur. The Commission unanimously agreed to this course of action.

At the 9 February 2017 meeting the Commission also approved a plan submitted by Fletcher Monuments of West Columbia, South Carolina, to continue the gravestone preservation project. This plan calls for the repair of five gravestones of various types and materials during 2017. It also includes some cleaning of stones where necessary.

The Commission will conduct its annual spring clean-up and grounds maintenance immediately after its scheduled business meeting on 11 May 2017. A major focus of this effort will center upon cutting and spraying the stumps and trees growing in proximity to the graveyard wall. The goal is to get all the growth and its associated root systems killed. We believe this will relieve pressure and promote the stability of the graveyard wall.

Recommendation: That this report be received as information.

The Commission on Minister & His Work met on Thursday, April 27 at 6 p.m. at Edgemoor ARP Church. The Commission acted on the request for the dissolution of the pastoral relationship between Blake Law and Calhoun ARP Church. The effective date of the dissolution is June 1, 2017 and he will receive a four month transition package or until he receives another call, whichever comes first. The Commission acted on the request for the dissolution of the call of Jeremiah Thomas as Associate Pastor of Grace ARP Church effective April 30, 2017. He is to begin as Pastor of Centennial ARP Church effective May 1, 2017. The Commission acted on the request that the pastoral relationship between Mark McDowell and First Presbyterian Church of Columbia as Associate Pastor be dissolved effective June 30, 2017. He will be Executive Director and Assistant Professor of Systematic Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary (Dallas, TX). The Commission acted on the request of the dissolution of the pastoral relationship between Brian Howard and Effingham ARP Church effective May 31, 2017. He began on June 1, 2017 as the Pastor of Adams Farm ARP Church (Jamestown, NC). The Commission acted on the request that the pastoral relationship between Glen Welsford and Oak Ridge ARP Church be dissolved effective June 25, 2017 upon his retirement

The Commission approved the supply agreement between Bethany ARP Church and Neely Gaston and appointed him as the interim moderator of the Bethany session. Pulpit committees have been elected at Oak Ridge ARP Church and Effingham ARP Church. The following interim moderators have been appointed: Calhoun ARP Church (Dean Rydbeck), Oak Ridge (Bob Elliott), Effingham (Andrew Basham) and Westminster (Kyle Sims).

The Commission also approved Mark McDowell to labor outside the bounds until March 31, 2018. The Commission also approved a student supply agreement between York ARPC and Jordan Bernard effective September 1, 2017.

The Campus Minister is responsible to raise 100% of the funds necessary to fulfill the provisions of this call as well as those necessary to support the Campus Ministry in total. All funds raised will be collected, receipted, and disbursed through the Office of Central Services of the General Synod of the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church.

John Rogers, Chairman of the Commission, introduced Mr. Luke Grigsby, as a student of theology. Mr. Grigsby gave a brief statement as to his calling. The Moderator then conducted the Service of Recognition for a Student of Theology after which Mr. Grigsby was enrolled as a student. Mr. Sims offered prayer.
