September 18-19, 2015

The Tennessee-Alabama Presbytery of the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church convened for its Fall Stated Meeting on September 18, 2015, at the Hopewell Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church in Culleoka, Maury County, Tennessee. Presbyters gathered at 3:00 p.m. and were led in prayer by the Moderator of the Presbytery, Mr. Charles Mangum.

Presbyters were dismissed to begin their respective Committee work. After the Committee meeting, the Presbyters and guests enjoyed a meal in the church's newly constructed Fellowship Hall.

At 7:00 p.m., Presbyters, guests, and members of Hopewell Church gathered together for worship. The sermon was delivered by Mr. Jeff Townsley, and the Sacrament of Communion was observed under the direction of Rev. Buddy Roberts.

FRIDAY BUSINESS SESSION

Moderator Mangum called the Presbytery to order at 8:30 p.m. and led the Presbyters in prayer. Greetings on behalf of the host church were delivered. The roll was constituted with a quorum present as follows:

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Having satisfactorily completed the requirements for ordination, Mr. Jeff Townsley received a pastoral call from the Lincoln Memorial ARP Church. The Minister and His Work Committee found the call to be in order, and presented it to the court. Mr. Townsley's ordination was sustained by the court. The Moderator then prayed a prayer of thanksgiving and gave a brief charge to Rev. Jeff Townsley.

Rev. Heyward encouraged the Minister and His Work Committee to begin presenting to the Court a written summary of the questions given to ordinands during the committee's examination.

The Treasurer's report (Attached) was given by Rev. Roy Hulling. A reminder was given that the annual assessment of \$3 per communing member is to be brought to the spring meeting of Presbytery.

Guests attending the meeting were then recognized. These included: Mrs Cathy Goodman (Hopewell ARP), Mrs. Joyce Edgar (Prosperity, TN), Mrs. Lisa Floyd (Connections ARP and President of Tennessee Alabama Women's Ministries), and Mrs. Bonnie Mitchell (Oak Hill).

Mrs. Lisa Floyd was given privilege of the floor and gave an update on women's ministry and activities in various churches.

The Clerk presented requests for excused absences from: Mr. Jeremiah Thomas (L), Rev. Man Park, and Rev. Soon Jeong Hwang. Rev. Bob Illman requested that Pablo Song also excused from the meeting due to his ongoing health issues which are being treated in Korea.

M/S/C - That the aforementioned Presbyters be excused from the meeting

The Moderator next read a letter addressed to the court from Mr. Matthew Gooch of the Cleveland Street ARP Church in New Albany, MS expressing their desire to withdraw their membership from the Tennessee-Alabama Presbytery. The evening being late, Moderator Mangum suggested that this be a matter of prayer and will be addressed during the Saturday session.

M/S/C - to adjourn. Rev. J Gregory Duke closed in prayer.

SATURDAY SESSION

The Moderator called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Rev. Buddy Roberts presented the morning devotional from Nehemiah 10:30-39

The Moderator dismissed the court for additional committee work.

The Court reconvened at 10:15a.m.

Rev. Bob Illman gave a report on the ministerial status of Rev. Kerry Ptacek.

M/S/C - to take action in accordance with the ARP Book of Discipline, Chapter VIII, Section 2, and proceed with the removal of Mr. Ptacek's from the roll of Presbytery. The Stated Clerk will send a letter (attached) communicating this action to Rev. Ptacek.

The matter of the Cleveland Street ARP Church, and their desire to withdraw from Presbytery, was brought before the Court. The Moderator reminded the Commission of their duties in this matter by reading from the Form of Government Chapter III, Section 13. The Commission members are Dr. Charles Edgar, Mr. Fred Hartin, Mr. Wesley Floyd, and Mr. Tom Neve. A update will be given at the next meeting of Presbytery.

M/S/C - to give the committee the authorization to spend up to \$1,000 for a title search and other matters to protect the interest of the Tennessee Alabama Presbytery.

The Moderator will establish a Committee to research and consider the matter of Presbytery incorporating as a 501c3 entity. Rev. Bob Illman, and Mr. Rob Nelson volunteered to serve on this committee; the Moderator will assign additional.

The Moderator called for reports from standing committees that were ready to report.

Stewardship

Rev. P.J. McClung reported and expressed thanks to God that giving to the Denomination Ministry Fund has risen over the past year. A report of DMF giving from churned in the Tenn-AL Presbytery will be distributed electronically within the next couple of weeks.

M/S/C - to receive the Stewardship Committee report.

Christian Education

Rev. Bryan Bult gave a brief report from the recent meeting of Christian Education Ministries in Greenville, SC. The Camp Horizon and Quest dates will be reversed in 2016. Supplemental teaching materials for the ARP Quarterly have been developed to assist those who are teaching Dr. Mark Ross's material. These are available at www.arpcem.org.

The committee is working toward presenting one of more training evening in the coming months: Teacher Training, Officer & Leadership Training, and Training in Women's Ministries.

Outreach Tennessee Alabama

Rev. Bob Illman rose and gave a brief report from the Committee, and presented the following motions:

- M/S/C That Rev. Duke assume Chairmanship of the Outreach Tennessee Alabama Committee due to Rev. Illman's move to California.
- M/S/C Presbytery modify the call to Rev. Soo Kim to add: "Hanmaum Mission to provide retirement through the ARP for Pastor Kim as early as possible."
- **M/S/C** That Presbytery continue giving \$400/ mo. to support the english speaking service @ Hanmaum Mission.

M/S/C - To receive New Day Church in Atlanta pending approval of 2nd Presbytery and General Synod.

M/S/C - To receive the Outreach Tennessee Alabama Committee report.

Minister & His Work

Rev. Buddy Roberts gave his report and made the following motions:

- **M/S/C** To approve and sustain licensure of Mr. Matthew Atteberry's examination. The Moderator asked Mr. Atteberry to come forward and asked him the Questions for Licensure from the Form of Government 9.24 (F). All were answered in the affirmative. A brief charge was given by the Moderator, and the right hand of fellowship was given by the Presbyters.
- M/S/C To approve Ordination of Jeff Townsley pending his preaching a sermon for the Presbytery. The committee found the details of his call to Lincoln Memorial ARP to be in order.
- M/S/C After an extended conversation concerning the complaint of Pastor Dana Crowell, it is moved that the Presbytery form a committee to meet with the Prosperity (TN) Pastor and Session for a pastoral meeting for prayer and Bible study to ask God to speak and give wisdom to their present condition at issue. The Moderator will appoint a committee to look into the matter.
- M/S/C That Mr. Matthew Atteberry be permitted to serve as Student Supply of Connections Presbyterian Church for one year ending on Sept. 19, 2016.
- M/S/C To receive the Minister & His Work Committee report.

Rev. P.J. McClung invited Presbyters to Pressly Memorial's 189th Homecoming on October 11th, 2015.
