Visitors were welcomed and introduced to the Presbytery.

John Barron spoke in place of Kyle E. Sims concerning the 2019 Synod meeting to be held in Beaver Falls, PA. Mr. Barron talked about the need for early registration.

Three ministers who recently retired were recognized by the Moderator.

- Jan Sattem spoke of the ministry of Robert M. Ferguson

Each of the retired ministers also spoke briefly of future plans.

The Moderator presented each of them a Certificate of Appreciation. Alan A. Morrow offered prayer. The Presbytery stood in appreciation of their ministry.

The memorial from the Good Shepherd Church on Denominational Ministry was listed as unfinished business. The memorial has been withdrawn and perhaps submitted at a later date.

L. Charles Hammond, a member of the Commission, introduced Joshua D. Smith to preach his Middler sermon. Mr. Smith read as his scripture Psalm 23. The Moderator thanked him for his message.

New business was considered.

The report of the Stated Clerk/Administrator was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE STATED CLERK/ADMINISTRATOR

Information:

- Brooks D. Willet was officially received into Catawba Presbytery on August 10, 2018 by transfer from Palmetto Presbytery, PCA.
- At the direction of the Commission David Caywood was removed as a Student of Theology effective August 21, 2018. Mr. Caywood joined a Baptist Church

- At the direction of the Commission Philip S. Bunch, Jr. was transferred to Tennessee Alabama Presbytery effective October 1, 2018.
- Dr. John R. de Witt, a member of our Presbytery since 2000 and former Senior Pastor of First Columbia and former Moderator of Synod, died September 30, 2018. The sympathy of the Presbytery is expressed to the de Witt family at the loss of their loved one. A tribute for Dr. de Witt will be prepared by Rev. David H. Lauten for inclusion in the Minutes of General Synod.

Action:

- The Executive Committee received a request in early August from the Hope Church, Pearland, Texas to sell a property owned by the Church. As outlined in the Rules of Procedure in Article V, Section 9, c the Executive Committee voted unanimously to act in behalf of Presbytery on an urgent matter. The Committee then voted unanimously to endorse the Hope plans to sell their property.

The Report of the Committee on Commitment and Finance was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON COMMITMENT AND FINANCE

Presbytery Assessment:

The Presbytery assessment for 2019 will be \$15.00 per communicant member. The \$15 will be disbursed as \$11.00 for Church Extension, \$3.50 for Presbytery operations and \$.50 for the Old Brick Church for 4 more years as approved earlier by Presbytery

Reminder:

The Presbytery Assessment is based on the figure reported by each session in the annual Statistical Report to Synod as of December 31st and recorded in the current Minutes of Synod under the statistical tables. It is this report of the Church’s communicant membership that is used to calculate the Presbytery Assessment.

Denominational Ministry Fund:

The Committee receives a summary of the annual Statistical Reports and has oversight of the Denominational Ministry Fund in the Presbytery. The summary for the giving to the 2018 Denominational Ministry Fund is as follows:

20% Giving	2 Churches
10-19% Giving	14 Churches
1-9 % Giving	24 Churches
No Commitment	8 Churches
Meeting DMF Goals:	2 Churches

FROM THE TREASURER OF CATAWBA PRESBYTERY

Fathers and Brothers,

In an effort to work smarter and more accurately, the Commitment and Finance Committee has granted my request to utilize our Accounting Software, PowerChurch, for budgeting purposes. In the past, Budgeting was done via Excel spreadsheets. This change presents information differently and I'd like to make sure the information is explained as thoroughly as possible.

For the 2019 Budget year, our assessments bring in a total of \$121,335.00. This is based on membership from the 2017 calendar year as submitted effective December 31, 2017 and recorded in the Minutes of Synod from June 2018. The breakdown of the assessments is as follows: Presbytery \$28,311.50, Church Extension \$88,979.00 and the OBC Tombstone Restoration (active through 2020) \$4,044.50.

For 2019, the Presbytery Expenses (including the Old Brick Church) come to a total of \$42,321.00. When you factor in the money that the OBC Endowment will use to help cover their expenses as well as the money designated for tombstone renovation there is a negative balance of (\$7,709.50.)

The Church Extension Expenses come to a total of \$90,750. There is an ONA Endowment Interest Check received every year that goes towards Church Extension work. Any monies required for Church Extension above and beyond the assessment are automatically pulled from the investment accounts. This is not a new practice but has been done for years when Presbytery approves Church Extension works that go above and beyond the Church Extension allotment of the assessment.

One final note: you will notice under "Income" on the Budget that I account for all income that Presbytery receives including monies from ONA towards Church Missions. This is done so that I can account for income from outside agencies and then account for the pass through back out to the individual missions.

The report of the Committee on Christian Education was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE CATAWBA PRESBYTERY CHRISTIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The Catawba Presbytery Christian Education Committee met on Monday, August 27 at Union ARP Church, Richburg, S.C. The following is a summary of that meeting.

Reports of past events:

Spring High School Super Retreat - The retreat was held at Bonclarken on March 2-4, 2018. This retreat is a joint effort between Catawba, First and Second Presbyteries. The Retreat theme was *Assurance of Faith* with Rev. Mackay Smith (Lake Wales ARP) being the keynote speaker and Will Milks leading the music. Mr. James Robbins (Ebenezer Youth) served as our director and Mr. Josh Valentine (Neely's Creek Youth) served as Assistant Director.

Spring Middle School Retreat - The retreat was held at Bonclarken on March 23-25, 2018. The retreat theme was *In Jesus we have every spiritual blessing* with Zach Keuthan being the keynote speaker and Dustin Ashenfelder leading the music. Rev. Jeremiah Thomas (Centennial ARP) served as our director and Mr. Josh Madsen (First Pres, youth) served as assistant director.

Youth Workers' Retreat - The retreat was held at Bethelwoods Camp, York, SC on February 16-17. The retreat theme was *Youth Worker Fellowship* with Rev. Andrew Shoger (Coddle Creek ARP) being the keynote speaker and Mr. Chris Holder (Neely's Creek Music)

leading the music. Mr. Josh Valentine (Neely's Creek Youth) served as our Director. This event served as our adult retreat offering for the year.

The Report and Supplemental Report of the Committee on Church Extension was presented and discussed as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION

The Committee on Church Extension has met three times since the summer Presbytery meeting. Our first meeting was held on Thursday, July 26th, 2018 at Bethel ARP, Winnsboro, SC. At this meeting, the new members (Mr. Mike Copeland, Rev. Benjamin Glaser & Rev. Mark Miller) were welcomed to the Committee. Written updates from our church planters were reviewed and discussed. The Committee discussed two potential works and took no action. Two potential elders for the provisional session for the Montage ARP mission work were presented – Mr. Dan Cannon, elder at First Presbyterian Columbia and Mr. Robby Woodard, elder at First Presbyterian Columbia. They were unanimously approved. The recommendation from our spring meeting was discussed, "the Committee also approved giving funds up to \$10,000 to Rev. Andes and his work at USC, pending his ongoing financial needs." The Committee approved to release \$10,000 from

our Church Extension Reserve fund (which currently is at \$779,944.88) per this recommendation, along with an additional \$10,000 from our operational reserves to help Rev. Andes and his family.

The Committee next met via conference call on Monday, August 27th. The Committee first talked with Rev. Clint Davis, who gave the Committee an update on Rev. Leon Brown's fundraising. The Committee then discussed a request from Rev. Rob Turner and Arsenal Hill that we continue to support them financially at the same level for this year as we had the previous year. This would be an additional \$10,000 for that work for this budget year (August 1, 2018 – August 1, 2019). This request was unanimously approved.

The Committee then met via conference call on Tuesday, September 4th. On this call, we heard from Rev. Leon Brown about his preparation for the Montage Church Mission in Los Angeles, CA. Rev. Brown shared with the Committee that a potential donation of up to \$500,000 that was discussed at the very beginning of this work will not be fulfilled. The loss of this donation has set Rev. Brown back considerably and has made it nearly impossible for him to get on the field on Oct. 29th. The Committee discussed this and unanimously approved giving Rev. Brown and the Montage work \$100,000 from our Church Extension Reserve fund as a one-time gift.

The Committee on Church Extension met via conference call on Monday, October 1st.

The Committee first talked with Mr. Gene Forsythe, who is a ruling elder with First Presbyterian Church (EPC) in Waskom, Texas about their interest in leaving the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC) and joining with the ARP through Catawba Presbytery. He explained the church's need for revitalization and their desire for our Presbytery to join them in this work. After talking to Mr. Forsythe, the Committee discussed this revitalization work and unanimously decided to not pursue it and to encourage Mr. Forsythe to keep talking to Mike Jones at ONA about the possibility of starting a new work there in the future.

The Committee also discussed the request from Rev. Leon Brown to opt out of the ARP Healthcare Plan since he is able to be on his wife's insurance plan. Central Services was also contacted about this and they advised that Rev. Brown would be able to opt out and be on his wife's plan. The Report of the Commission on the Old Brick Church was presented and RECEIVED AS INFORMATION as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF OLD BRICK CHURCH (OBC)

The Commission met on two occasions: 4 May '18 and 9 August '18, since its last report to Presbytery. The 4 May meeting convened at the OBC in western Fairfield County, South Carolina; and the 9 August meeting convened at Bethel A.R.P Church in Winnsboro, South Carolina. The

Commission has scheduled its next meeting for 15 November '18 at the OBC in western Fairfield County.

Items:

2018 Gravestone Preservation – Fletcher Monuments of West Columbia, South Carolina, completed the 2018 gravestone preservation work in April '18 on 11 gravestones. The work focused on securing dies to bases, leveling, and cleaning stones. Additionally, a cracked marble top on a box tomb also received repair; and a marble monolith was excavated, splinted, and reinstalled.

Burial Policy – At the 4 May '18 and 9 August '18 meetings the Commission continued review and discussion of a “draft” burial policy for the OBC's graveyard. The policy is addressing questions of eligibility, application procedures, cost, arrangement responsibilities, and acceptable types of gravestones. The Commission targets its 15 November '18 meeting for final approval of the policy. The Commission is currently working with a lady, whose husband is interred in the graveyard, to finalize her burial arrangements in a plot adjacent to her husband.

Grounds Maintenance – After the 4 May '18 business meeting, the Commission conducted grounds maintenance and clean-up in the graveyard and the area outside the graveyard walls. Recent bush-hogging and a planned, additional application of herbicide around the wall and the bush-hog inaccessible areas is needed to deal with the exceptional growth this spring and summer has yielded.

2019 Gravestone Preservation – At its 9 August business meeting, the Commission approved a proposal by Fletcher Monuments to repair a box tomb in a significantly deteriorated state. Without attention the tomb will collapse with further damage to itself and possibly other, adjacent box tombs. Additionally, the John Bell family plot is under consideration for preservation work in 2019. Overall, the preservation effort over the past 4 years has helped preserve many of the old monuments, while significantly improving the overall appearance of the graveyard and demonstrating respect for our forebears.

The Chairman of the Commission checked with the Executive Director of Synod and found out all was in order with the call.

The Commission met on Monday, August 27, 2018 at Centennial ARP Church in Columbia, SC. The Commission met with David Cashin from Crossings Community ARPC with regard to a supply agreement. The Commission examined Aaron Swartz (Chaplain U.S. Army, Major) for transfer from the Evangelical Church Alliance International to Catawba Presbytery (ARPC). The Commission reconsidered Andy Stager's request to labor outside the bounds as senior minister of the International Protestant Church of Zurich, Switzerland at his request. The Commission Reviewed the terms of call for Paul Robelot from World Witness. Interim moderators were appointed for the following churches: Crossings (James McManus), Hill City (Buzzy Elder), Rogers Memorial (Mark Miller), Sherwood Forest (Neal Mathias). The Commission received notice that

Philip Bunch has accepted a call as minister to the Fayetteville ARP Church of the Tennessee-Alabama Presbytery (ARPC). The Stated Clerk was authorized to issue his transfer effective October 1, 2018. The Commission has received notice of the retirement of Robert Ferguson as minister of Faith Fellowship ARPC (Houston, TX) effective November 1, 2018.

The Commission met with the candidate and pulpit search committee from Grace ARPC. The candidate was examined for transfer and the terms of call were reviewed.

The Commission met on Thursday, October 4, 2018 at 6 p.m. at First Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church of Rock Hill, SC. 9. Grant you an annual vacation of **4** weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod
11. Other:
 - Community/Hospitality Allowance \$3,000
 - Cell Phone Allowance \$1,000
 - Books & Resource Allowance \$ 500
12. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - a. To continue **for a minimum of three months** the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.

The Call to Mr. Kent was presented to him and accepted.

The terms of the Call from the Faith Fellowship for Dr. David B. Huang were APPROVED as follows:

We the officers and members of Faith Fellowship Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church of Cypress, Texas, being well satisfied with your ministerial qualifications, and confident that we have been led to you by the Holy Spirit as one whose ministry will be profitable to our spiritual interest, do earnestly call you, **Dr. David B Huang**, to undertake the call as **Associate Pastor of Missions of Faith Fellowship Church**. This is a **Part-Time Bi-Vocational Call based on 10 to 15 hour per week**. - You have waived inclusion in Synod's life, and health and dental insurance program, as you and your wife and daughter are fully covered by your policy **with United Healthcare through your company, Motif Biosciences, Inc.**
- Time to be away for evangelistic, missionary, or other church related meetings, as needed.
- Time to be away to tend to your medical business, as needed.
- To pay the expenses of your travel to Presbytery and Synod meetings.
- Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
 - Vacation 4 weeks

- 8. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise to continue **for a minimum of three months** the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's or your own insurance program.
- 9. In the event you should die during the terms of this call, we promise to continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary for your immediate family **for a minimum of three months**.
