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A word from your Synod Planning Committee:

Fathers and Brothers,

Greetings in the name of our glorious Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ! I hope and pray that everyone is well and prospering in the growth and grace of His faithful glory as we enter a new year with many exciting possibilities for our witness of Christ to the world.

The purpose of this letter is to inform the members of the court of the plan for the ARP General Synod to fully return to Bonclarken Conference Center (after an absence of 3 years) for our annual meeting. I would personally like to take this opportunity to inform you as to what is anticipated, as well as to strongly encourage every eligible member of the court of the ARP General Synod to make plans to physically attend the 218th Stated Meeting of the ARP General Synod (June 7-9, 2022) at Bonclarken Conference Center (Flat Rock, NC).

Bonclarken is excited to see the synod return and they are looking forward to seeing everyone on the grounds again. Construction on the property has been completed and the internet services have all been upgraded. A new building called the "Back Porch" has been constructed close to the YAB and will be operational. In addition, Bonclarken Conference Center is celebrating its 100th anniversary this year and we give thanks to God for His gracious providence in their celebration of this milestone.

It is anticipated that all eligible members of the ARP General Synod will be physically present for attendance at this meeting, but virtual participation by electronic means will be allowed in certain circumstances. The following "Recommendation #3" from the Minutes of the 2021 General Synod (pg. 42) was approved:

"Those members of the court residing outside the continental U.S. or baving emergency situations of illness, financial bardship or exceptional circumstances, shall be allowed, by agreement of the Principal Clerk and Moderator of Synod, to participate in any meeting of the General Synod that is broadcast electronically, with the approval of that meeting of the General Synod (as one of the first items of business)."

As a result, an electronic link will be made available to all members of the court who will be allowed to attend General Synod as "virtual delegates" under the terms of this provision. It is to be noted that this provision is by agreement of the Principal Clerk and the Moderator of Synod. It is highly recommended that anyone hoping to make use of this provision must contact the Principal Clerk and the Moderator of Synod with their request prior to registering for General Synod as "virtual delegates" to General Synod.

At this time, there are no state or health restrictions in place that will prohibit the General Synod from meeting as we have formerly done in the past prior to Covid-19. As we move through the next few months, further communications will be made available on any safety protocols that may be implemented (as we become aware of them). If an alternate "Plan B" is required for the meeting of synod, information will be sent out as soon as is feasibly possible with any new information.





The church is called to gather together for worship, prayer, fellowship, encouragement, comfort and to share in the sacraments in the love of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. As a synod, we are also called (through our polity) to gather for all of the above reasons, but also for the leadership, administration and deliberation of a court of the church of Jesus Christ through the meeting of General Synod. Although it is not always easy or enjoyable work, it is still the work of the synod to discuss and deliberate on matters which come before the court and it must be done to our Father's greater glory. Let us give thanks for God's gracious provisions and pray for His continued blessing on our lives as we look forward to the necessity and work as a court of Christ's church here on earth.

"Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, even Jesus our Lord, equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen." Hebrews 13: 20-21 (ESV)

I look forward to seeing everyone again at Bonclarken in June 2022.



FAQs - frequently asked questions

How do I sign up for a Synod packet of reports if I am not registering as a delegate? Only registered voting delegates will receive the link to the report packet in May. Closer to the meeting date, an electronic link will be available upon request.

What is available for my wife and children during Synod?

As more details become available, we will update this site with that information. For now we know that ARP Women's Ministries will be offering some gatherings (Women's Welcome and Oasis) specifically for women. Other groups will provide opportunities as well (a Pastors' Wives Get-Together, Church Planter/Missionary Wives Gathering, Erskine BBQ, and some time for adventure, recreation and pool time at Bonclarken.) Kids Camp and Child Care will not be available this year.

Must I register if I am not a voting delegate?

Yes, please! It is not mandatory that you register and there is no fee, however it is helpful for us to have a record of visitors present.

What happens if I register after the deadline?

Register by April 27: Synod reports will be distributed via an electronic link on May 9th allowing adequate time to read and consider information.

Registrations received between April 27 and May 24: The electronic link will be emailed as registrations are received allowing limited time to read and consider information. To register after May 24, register onsite and receive an electronic link onsite. NO mail or online registrations accepted after May 24.

Why must I sign in at Bonclarken if I've already registered ahead of time?

You are not an official voting delegate until you have signed the Official Roll of Synod, which is an historical record of those present. The Official Roll also serves as the document by which a quorum is determined.
