Conference Clinicians

Dr. Rollo Dilworth – Adult Clinician

Rollo Dilworth is Vice Dean and Professor of Choral Music Education in the Department of Music Education and Therapy at Temple University's Center for the Performing and Cinematic Arts in Philadelphia, PA. He began his tenure there in 2009. From 1996-2009, he served on the faculty of North Park University in Chicago. Over 200 of Dilworth's choral compositions and arrangements appear in the catalogs of Hal Leonard, Colla Voce and Santa Barbara Music Publishing. He has authored 3 books of choral warm up exercise for choral ensembles of all levels. Dilworth is a frequent guest conductor of all-state, honors, festival, community, church, and professional choirs. He is an active clinician and presenter on topics including African American choral music, composing/arranging for choirs, urban music education, and community engagement.

Todd Arant – Youth Choir Clinician

Todd Arant serves as the Director of Traditional Worship Arts at Apex United Methodist Church in Apex, NC, where he oversees a vibrant worship arts ministry including vocal and instrumental choirs for adults, youth, and children. He holds degrees from Furman University, Emory University, and The Institute for Worship Studies. He is the Past President of the North Carolina Chapter for the Fellowship of United Methodists in Music and Worship Arts and also serves as President-Elect of the Board of Directors for Choristers Guild. Todd is married to Allison and a proud father of three children: Clarkson, Anna Rast, and Sims.

Victor C. Johnson – Middle School Clinician

Victor C. Johnson, a native of Dallas, Texas, is the School Choral Editor for *Sing!*, the educational publishing division of Choristers Guild. A prolific composer and arranger, he has over 350 choral works, vocal solo books, and keyboard collections currently in print. Prior to his position at Choristers Guild, from 2000-2018, Victor was a choral director at Ft. Worth Academy of Fine Arts (FWAFA). At FWAFA, Victor directed the Academy Singers, Academy Men's Choir and was Artistic Director of the Singing Girls of Texas and Children's Choir of Texas. Victor is in demand as a guest conductor, adjudicator, and clinician for music educators and students throughout the United States. He has conducted All-State and Regional Honor choirs in the US and Canada. His own choirs have performed at the Texas Music Educators Association Convention in 2011 and 2014 as well as the American Choral Directors Association-Southwest Division conference in March, 2016. His professional affiliations include: American Choral Directors Association, Texas Music Educators Association, National Association for Music Education, Texas Choral Directors Association, ASCAP, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Inc.

Elizabeth Shepley – Junior Choir Clinician

Elizabeth Shepley has enjoyed 40 years as a teacher and conductor working with children and youth in public and private schools, community music programs, and church choir schools. She is Artistic Director Emerita of the Northfield Youth Choirs, and served as the Director of the House of Hope Presbyterian Church Choir School in St. Paul and Director of Children's music at Bethel Lutheran Church in Northfield. Liz holds a MA in Music Education with a Kodály emphasis (University of St. Thomas), a BA in Music Education (Concordia College, Moorhead, MN) and certifications in both Kodály and Orff-Schulwerk. Further music study has taken her to the Institut Jaques-Dalcroze in Switzerland, the Orff Institute in Austria, The Kodály Institute in Hungary, and the Royal School of Church Music in England. Liz has chaired inner city music programs in Minneapolis and St. Paul, and has served as President of the Twin Cities Chapter of Choristers Guild, as a board member of MN-ACDA and as an adjunct professor at Luther Seminary. She is currently serving on the Choristers Guild National Board of Directors. Liz has led conferences and festival choirs nationwide, and choirs under her direction have performed across the United States, Canada and Europe. Liz loves to golf, cook, read, bike & travel, and together with her husband, Bob, keep up with her four adult sons.

Susan Eernisse – Cherub and Primary Choir Clinician

Susan Eernisse earned her Bachelor of Music and Master of Education degrees from Berry College. She completed Levels I, II, and III of Orff-Schulwerk Certification at Shorter University and the University of Kentucky. Susan taught elementary music in public and private schools for 20 years, and has also taught courses in music education at the college level. She currently serves as Associate Music Minister, along with her husband, Glenn, at the First Baptist Church of Gainesville Georgia. Susan is a veteran writer and freelance editor of children's music teaching materials, including work for Growing in Grace Children's Music Curriculum and Choristers Guild. She is a respected children's choir clinician, and has served on the faculties of children's music camps and festivals for many years.

General Information

Medical Issues: Should an accident or injury occur that requires a hospital visit, a chaperone or church member from your group is responsible for taking the person to the hospital or urgent care. It is the church's responsibility to obtain medical forms, release forms and any other items pertaining to medical issues or medication during the time of the conference. Be sure to let the Bonclarken Office know.

Chaperones: One non-singing adult chaperone must accompany every ten participants and must accompany young children swimming. All participants (even one or two) are required to have an adult chaperone on the Bonclarken grounds. Chaperones are responsible for checking on all participants at all rehearsals and activities and enforcing Quiet Time.

Children's Church: This activity is for Junior, Primary, and Cherub choir members in the Rec Building. Children's Church will take place each morning during Morning Worship. Cherubs and Primaries will be escorted to crafts, recreation, or rehearsal by Music Conference counselors to the Rec Building, where they will be served a snack before Children's Church. Cherubs should be picked up PROMPTLY AT 10:40 AM in the old gym. Primary Choir members will be escorted to their next rehearsal by the counselors. Junior Choir members will join Children's Church at 10:20 AM after their rehearsal and will be escorted to their next activity by the counselors.

Nibble Nook Devotions: Nibble Nook Devotions are held nightly at 9:45 PM for Middle School and Youth Choir members, chaperones, and adults.

Snacks and soft drinks: These are available for purchase at the Nibble Nook. Hours are: Monday - Thursday from 1:00 - 5:00 PM, 7:45 - 11:00 PM. Friday hours are 1:00 - 5:00, 9:00 - midnight.
