Catawba Presbytery met June 5, 2007 in Convocation Center at Bonclarken Conference Center, Flat Rock North Carolina. The Moderator, Robert E. Patrick, Jr, called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

Mr. Patrick constituted the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Patrick introduced Mr. Tom Patterson, Moderator of the General Synod. Mr. Patterson brought greetings from the General Synod. He spoke of the many changes underway at the denominational offices. He spoke of the need of Presbyteries to reach out and help smaller Presbyteries and commended Catawba for the outreach to the Texas and Louisiana areas. Mr. Patterson spoke as well of the growing need for new subscriptions to enable the magazine to continue and encouraged churches and ministers to help out by subscribing. He encouraged local churches to be more than local in their vision and to learn more about the Church and its work and that the time is critical to the magazine and to the work of the Synod as a source of information. He encouraged prayer for all levels of our work and to be involved.

Commission member Seth Yi introduced Andrew R. Stager, a student at RTS-Charlotte, to preach his Middler sermon. Mr. Stager used as his scripture Mark 1:21- 31. The Moderator thanked him for his message.

The report of the Committee on Church Extension was presented and discussed as follows:

**REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION**

The Committee met twice since the last Presbytery Meeting, on March 27<sup>th</sup> at First ARP Lancaster and on April 26<sup>th</sup> at Crossings Community Church in Columbia.

The purpose of the first meeting was to meet Ken Priddy, the Synod’s new Director of Church Renewal and Revitalization. Rev. Priddy informed us of his upcoming plans in church renewal, and how he can be of service to the Presbytery and churches.

At the meeting of the 26<sup>th</sup>, we discussed the following topics:

*Hope, Pearland, Texas*

The Hope mission submitted letter requesting organization on June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2007, along with a copy of the proposed call to Gentry McColm. The request passed, pending an official letter from the provisional session. The committee agreed to pay the chairman’s expenses to attend the organizational service as a representative of the committee.

*Indian Land Mission*

The committee was informed that Outreach North America has approved funds for an intern to work at Indian Land in 2007, matching Presbytery funds for 2007. This would take effect when the committee decides upon an intern for this work.

*IBL*

Members of the committee, while well satisfied with the performance of J. J. Diaz, expressed concern for the financial health and future of the work. Members of the provision session of IBL will attempt to arrange a meeting with J. J. Diaz and the local ARP churches to determine the best course to pursue.

*Providence Mission*

The committee conducted a meeting with Richard Brown and four members of the mission regarding their beliefs and practice on family worship. After talking with these men, the committee discovered the following:

1. That the mission has between 8 and 11 solid families in regular attendance, and sees itself organizing before the end of the year.
2. That the men meet weekly with Richard Brown for extensive training and mutual accountability to become more effectively fathers and husbands.
3. That while there are no age or gender based Sunday schools, there are age-based small groups meeting at other times, both formally and informally. Wives and mothers meet regularly together. One member holds an outreach-based youth group at his home, with about a dozen young people present, mostly from outside the church. This group has seen several commitments to Christ. Children get together informally for fellowship and teaching.

4. That the families in the church are trained and practice lifestyle evangelism. The group does include families whose children attend public schools, as well as homes where the fathers do not participate. While the structure of the church is family-based, there is good evidence of fruitful ministry among singles and people from unconverted homes.
5. That the group expressed no problems with the Standards or practices of the ARP church, and are willing to follow all directives of Presbytery.
6. That the provisional session of the church takes an active part in supervising Richard Brown's work, and visits the group regularly.
7. That while the structure of this work is unusual, the committee cannot find anything in this work that is out of line with the Standards.

The Committee feels that we should encourage this group to organize and become self supporting as soon as possible. While unusual, they are certainly not unorthodox, and hold to the same values of outreach, worship, and Christian education as the committee.

The Committee makes the following recommendations to Presbytery

1. That Ken Priddy be given time in the Fall meeting to present a program on renewal to the Presbytery at the Fall meeting.
2. That the Hope mission in Pearland, Texas be approved for organization, pending all necessary legal steps.
3. That a portion of Church Extension's unallocated funds be set aside for the hiring of an intern for the Indian Land mission, when a suitable candidate is found and approved by Presbytery.
4. That special prayer be given for the Providence mission in Mt Pleasant, IBL in Columbia, the organization of the Hope mission, and for the work in Indian Land.

Recommendation 2 was ADOPTED.

Recommendation 3 was discussed and AMENDED "to hire an individual to explore the Indian Land Mission" when a suitable candidate is found and approved by Presbytery". The amendment was ADOPTED. The motion was ADOPTED AS AMENDED.

Recommendation 4 was ADOPTED. James Barker offered prayer for the missions of the Presbytery.

Billy Fleming presented a motion that was ADOPTED as follows: That the Presbytery approve the request of the Hope Mission Provisional Session for \$35,000 from ONA's Matching Grant Program pending approval by the Presbytery Committee on Church Extension.

Mr. Fleming presented a second motion that was ADOPTED as follows: That the Presbytery approve the application submitted by the Hope Mission Provisional Session for \$150,000 from

the ONA Revolving Loan Fund pending approval by the Presbytery Committee on Church Extension.

The report of the Stated of the Church Committee was presented and RECEIVED AS INFORMATION as follows:

### **REPORT OF THE STATE OF THE CHURCH COMMITTEE**

The Committee has met once since the Spring, 2007, meeting of Presbytery. We are pleased to report that with the able assistance of Leland Beaudrot, our Communications Clerk, we will have posted [by the time of our summer stated meeting] an initial “list of resources for the care of pastors and their families” through a link for documents of Catawba Presbytery on Synod’s website. [Please see attachment for draft of initial list of suggested resources.] Access to this list will require clicking acceptance of the attached disclaimer, as reported to the March 14, 2006, meeting of Presbytery. The Committee continues to welcome suggestions of other resources (various professionals, websites, books, conferences, etc.) for helping pastors and their families dealing with various types of crises.

The Committee has reviewed the Annual Reports for 2006 and continues to be concerned about the failure of some congregations to be represented by elder delegates at stated meetings of Presbytery and Synod. This failure only exacerbates the discrepancy between ruling elder and teaching elder representation in the courts of the church. We have 5 sessions which did not send an elder delegate to two out of three stated meetings of Catawba Presbytery last year and one session was not represented at any of the three stated meetings. [In 2005 we had 1 session without delegates at two out of three stated meetings and 3 without representation at any stated meetings.] Our Committee is following internal procedures to express our pastoral concern to individual sessions and encourage greater participation, but would advise the presbytery that if a congregation continues to fail to provide ruling elder delegates to more than one stated meeting per year for three years in a row, then the matter may be referred to the Commission on the Minister & His Work. We also had 6 churches which did not have elder delegate representation at either of the past two meetings of the General Synod and one which was not represented for at least the last three years.

Members of the Committee continue to seek to reach out in a pastoral manner to a number of our pastors and churches who are in challenging circumstances. Please pray that the Lord would give us wisdom and use us in this ministry.

The Committee has no recommendations at this time.

Sequel to McDonald's popular *Ordering Your Private World*, this book contains McDonald's lessons and reflections after dealing with moral failure in his own life.

Brooks Faulkner, *Wounded Minister: Healing From and Preventing Personal Attacks*

An good book for ministers on how to recover from a church conflict.

Marshall Shelley, *Well-Intentioned Dragons*.

This book on dealing with difficult people in the church has been around for several years now, and has proven to be useful especially for young ministers.

G. Lloyd Rediger, *Clergy Killers: Guidance for Churches and Congregations Under Attack*.

Hugh F. Halverstadt, *Managing Church Conflict*.

Another writer from a mainline perspective, applying conflict resolutions principles to the ministry

Rodney J. Crowell, *Musical Pulpits: Clergy and Laypersons Face The Issue of Forced Exits*.

Crowell's book is based on his doctoral studies on clergy in forced exit situations.

He gives a wealth of statistical information and helpful resources.

Rabbi Thomas B. Friedman, *Generation to Generation*.

The report of the Commission on the Minister and His Work was presented item by item as follows:

### **REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK**

The Commission met Thursday, May 24, 7 pm at First Rock Hill ARP Church.

The following business was transacted:

- A.** The Commission met with the Pulpit Search Committee from Living Waters' Church in order to examine their Call for Rev. David Zimmerman as Senior Pastor. The Commission found the Call to be in order prior to discussing the Call with Rev. Zimmerman. The Commission granted Rev. Zimmerman the right to move to the field. The call becomes effective Tuesday, June 5, 2007.
- B.** The Commission had a teleconference with the Pulpit Search Committee from the Hope Mission in order to examine their call to the Rev. Gentry McColm as Pastor. The Commission found the call to be in order prior to discussing the call with Rev. McColm. The call becomes effective June 24, 2007.
- C.** The Commission received a letter from the Neely's Creek Session concerning their situation related to not providing the cost of living increase for the Rev. Denny Heber. The Commission is following up with the Session.
- D.** The Commission discussed several questions posed from the Arsenal Hill Session related to the cost of living increase. A representative of the Commission will meet with the Session.
- E.** The Commission discussed several items related to students under care of Presbytery including the possibility of placing appropriate literature into new students' hands.
- F.** The Commission has established a sub-committee to study policies concerning Harassment and Sexual Misconduct.
- G.** The Commission appointed the Rev. David H. Lauten to serve as the Moderator of the Calhoun Presbyterian Church Session.

Recommendations:

1. That the actions of the Commission reported above be sustained.
2. That the Middler Sermon of Student of Theology, Andrew Stager be received as a specimen of progress.

3. That the Presbytery revise the Rules of Procedure p.39 Appendix A, Section 2, h.(7) to read: “Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall provide a cost of living adjustment (add) **to the previous year’s base salary**. The cost of living...”
4. That the installation service date and Commission of Rev. Zimmerman at Living Waters be authorized through the Acting Chairman of the Commission.
5. That the installation service of Rev. McColm at Hope Presbyterian Church be authorized though the Acting Chairman of the Commission and in consultation with the Commission to organize the Hope Mission as a congregation.
6. That special prayer be offered for the Chairman of the Commission, the Rev. William R. Roberts.

Recommendation 3 was discussed and ADOPTED.

The Call from the Living Waters Church for Mr. Zimmerman as Senior Pastor was read and APPROVED with the following terms:

1. When a housing allowance is provided, it shall provide  
Total Compensation of \$42,000 which includes
  - a. Base Salary \$24,000
  - b. Housing allowance \$16,800
  - c. Travel allowance \$ 1,200
2. Pay your moving expenses.
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Pay 100% of Synod’s life and health and dental insurance for the pastor.
5. Pastor waives medical and/or dental coverage under Synod’s group policy for his dependents who are covered under the spouse’s group policy with reimbursement of the costs by the Church of the dependents
6. One week to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall provide cost of living adjustments based on the amount provided by Synod’s Director of the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Center.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod’s insurance program, we promise:

- a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
- 12. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
  - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

The call was presented to Mr. Zimmerman and was accepted.

Recommendation 4 was ADOPTED.

The Call from the Hope Church for Mr. McColm as Pastor was read with the following terms:

- 1. When a housing allowance is provided, it shall provide Total Compensation of \$45,000 which includes
  - a. Base Salary \$24,500
  - d. Housing allowance \$20,500
  - e. Travel allowance \$ 0
- 2. Pay your moving expenses.
- 3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
- 4. Provide 100% of Synod's life, and health, and dental insurance package for the pastor and his family.

- 8. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
- 9. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
- 10. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
  - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
- 11. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
  - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

The call was APPROVED and accepted by Mr. McColm.

Recommendation 5 was ADOPTED.

Recommendation 6 was ADOPTED.

- C. The Commission accepted the proposal of Mr. John Swearingen of Winnsboro, S.C., for maintaining the church grounds.
- D. The Commission verified that a quitclaim deed for the church property has been filed at the Fairfield County courthouse.
- E. The Commission charged Mr. Pat Patrick and Dr. Harmon Patrick to obtain quotes for and proceed with the removal of two dead trees on church property pending the availability of funds.
- F. The Commission appointed Rev. Kyle Sims and Mr. Paul Gettys to draft a resolution acknowledging the care and faithfulness of Bethel A.R.P. Church, Winnsboro, S.C., in maintaining the OBC property over the years, to be presented at the stated meeting of Catawba Presbytery in October 2007.
- G. The Commission is investigating options for on-site fire suppression as well as liability insurance for the Old Brick Church property.
- H. The Commission has set a goal to obtain a conditions assessment and preservation plan to be applied for in calendar year 2007, with funding from the Commission not to exceed \$5000. This plan will guide the ongoing maintenance and rehabilitation of the Old Brick Church property.
- I. The Commission decided to petition Catawba Presbytery for funding of \$5000 for the purpose of obtaining a conditions assessment and preservation plan.
