Guy H. Smith, Stated Clerk/Administrator, constituted the roll from the enrollment cards. [APPENDIX A] A quorum was declared present. Visitors were welcomed and encouraged to sign the visitor's card.

In matters of unfinished business, the report of the Commitment and Finance Committee was presented on the final report on the sale of the Gold Hill Property. A motion was made and ADOPTED that the report be received as information as follows:

#### FINAL REPORT ON GOLD HILL ROAD PROPERTY SALE

In accord with Catawba Presbytery's directive to sell the Gold Hill Road property formerly known as the Carolina Covenant Church, God blessed your committee with a quick and uneventful sale. We received a commercial appraisal for that property from Mr. Joe Versen in York, SC, and he reported a range of value from \$800,000 to \$900,000. Your Committee met with a prospective buyer (Grace Community United Methodist Church), and began negotiations to sell the property and its contents to the Grace congregation. We came to an agreement for a \$900,000 purchase price for the property, building and contents.

The closing was held on June 28, 2010 where the Presbytery realized net proceeds of \$785,664 (please see attached settlement statement) after paying off the remaining mortgage and other incidental charges. The committee offers our thanks to Mr. Tom

Roper, a former moderator of Catawba Presbytery, and elder in the First Rock Hill congregation, for his advice and assistance through all of the legalities involved with this transaction.

While this property was under our committee's care, net expenses totaled \$12,626.33 for utilities, mortgage payments, lawn maintenance, insurance, etc (please see the Treasurer's attached expense report). In accord with Presbytery's directive, this expense money will be refunded to Presbytery from the \$785,664, with the remaining balance to be invested for future use by Presbytery for church planting in York County.

We give thanks to God for His blessing upon us through this process, and the way in which He can use even the closing of a church for His glory and the good of His kingdom through the evangelical congregation meeting there now, and future church plants to come from the financial resources realized through the sale of the property.

The report of the Committee on Commitment and Finance was presented and discussed as follows:

#### REPORT OF COMMITMENT AND FINANCE COMMITTEE

The Commitment and Finance Committee met on September 2, 2010 in order to prepare a proposed budget for Catawba Presbytery for the year 2011. This proposed budget is based upon the latest number available for active members within the Presbytery: 7,287. Fortunately, that number has increased over last year's membership by 460.

This proposed budget assumes that some fund-raising will take place in 2011 by the Outreach Committee for IBL. Due to a request from Outreach, this budget includes a grant of \$11,000 to IBL, which will cover their pastor the first quarter of 2011. Half of this grant is from Presbytery operating funds, and the other half from available funds through the Church Extension budget. Our proposed budget also includes a grant to the Old Brick Church Commission for ongoing work on the denominational historical site. This grant is provided through Presbytery operating funds. Two years ago, we petitioned Synod for \$10,000 for much of this work, and hopefully the Old Brick Church Commission will receive all or at least some of those funds in Synod's 2012 budget.

Your Committee continues to appreciate the fine way in which the congregations of Catawba Presbytery pay their commitments of \$ 15.00 per active member, and we appreciate the accurate and informative job that Mr. Lever does for Presbytery as Treasurer. Recommendation:

That the attached proposed budget for 2011 be approved.

#### REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Catawba Presbytery's Christian Education Committee met at 7:00 pm on August 30, 2010 at Chester ARP Church. Your Committee received and examined various reports from the director's of the Presbytery's existing ministries. The following statistical data was received as information and passed on to you for the same purpose.

- Spring High School Super Retreat (First, Second and Catawba Presbyteries) 13 churches participated from Catawba Presbytery with an attendance numbered at 155 persons. The total attendance from all presbyteries was 354.
- Spring Middle School Retreat 12 churches participated with a total attendance of 155.
- **Children's Retreat** The 2010 Children's Retreat was held at Unity ARP Church on March 20, 2010. #6 children participated along with 9 chaperones and 13 staff.
- **Senior Adult Retreat** 9 churches participated with a total attendance of 147. The retreat was held at First Presbyterian Church in Columbia.

Your Committee also received and approved the following report from the Middle School Retreat Director and pass it on to Presbytery for approval.

• Fall Middle School Retreat – The fall retreat for Middle School students is scheduled for November 5-7, 2010 at Bonclarken. Tyler Griffin, the Junior High Youth Leader at First Presbyterian Church (PCA) in Augusta, Georgia, will speak to the youth about maturing in their faith. John Levister and friends from Chester and Rock Hill will lead worship. The cost is \$70 per student.

Your Committee would remind the Presbytery that it has already approved the plans for the Fall Senior High Retreat. Because the retreat is scheduled for September 24-26, 2010, which is before Presbytery meets, your committee submitted those plans at the March stated meeting of Presbytery. Your committee discussed various other issues regarding attendance, timing and location of the various education ministries of Catawba Presbytery.

#### **Recommendations:**

- 1. That the plans for the Fall Middle School Retreat be approved.
- 2. That the Presbytery encourage church participation in its educational ministries.

The report of the Committee on Church Extension and the Supplemental Report of the Committee on Church Extension were presented and ADOPTED as follows:

#### REPORT OF THE CHURCH EXTENSION COMMITTEE

The Committee is encouraged by the work of several churches in our Presbytery. The current works include Indian Land, which is in its second year, and Grace which is still in a planning and search phase.

At this time we continue to support the Indian Land mission, and the Mission developer, Gary Stiltner, according to the original time line and funding plan. As always, Gary could use prayer support, financial support, and hands-on help.

Grace is the new work that is proceeding with the guidance of First Columbia. They have made good progress and are currently searching for a Mission Developer.

We have several churches in the Rock Hill area that are working together in a Parenting Church Community to plant new churches in York County. This team effort is being guided by Global Church Advancement and funded by Outreach North America.

Our Committee recommended two members to the current Church Plant Assessment; they are Steve Reynolds and Andrew Stager.

Our plans for the coming year include programs for church revitalization and new church development. Our proposed budget has funds available to handle future requests if needed.

- ➤ Plans are underway to host a cemetery preservation workshop at the OBC on Saturday, 26 March 2011 to be conducted by Dr. Michael Trinkley of the Chicora Foundation, Columbia, S.C. The workshop will be promoted throughout the denomination as well as to local historical and genealogical groups.
- > Tree removal and landscaping continue as ongoing projects to beautify the property, provide additional parking, and stabilize the condition of the cemetery wall.

The Commission met with the Westminster ARP Session and received a request that the Rev. Randy Riddle, a retired PCA pastor and member of the Palmetto Presbytery of the PCA serve as stated supply.

To assist in providing clarity to the Presbytery's understanding of the annual cost of living increase and confirm the language of the Rules of Procedure with the practice of the Presbytery, the Commission has drafted the following amendment to The Rules of Procedure: That Appendix A, Section 1, (7) be amended to read: "Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall provide a(n) cost of living adjustment increase to the previous year's base salary compensation."

The Commission is in communication with the Faith ARP Session about their supply arrangement.

- 4. Provide Synod's life, and health and dental insurance package for the pastor and his family. 5. The Church provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.
- 6. Two weeks to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
- 7. One week and expenses for continuing education
- 8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall provide a cost of living adjustment to the previous year's base salary.
- 9. Grant you an annual vacation of 5 weeks.
- 10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
- 11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
  - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
- 12. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:

a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for your immediate family for a minimum of three months.

Under the direction of the Commission Mr. Taylor began his work on July 1, 2010. The call was presented by the Moderator and accepted.

Recommendation 2 was ADOPTED.

Recommendation 3 was ADOPTED.

Mr. Auten spoke of his faith journey. The Moderator conducted the Service of Recognition for Mr. Auten. He was enrolled as a Candidate. Paul Pepin, his pastor, offered prayer for Mr. Auten.

Recommendation 4 was ADOPTED.

Recommendation 5 was presented and discussed.

A motion was made and ADOPTED that Rules be set aside so that recommendation 5 can be considered for approval at this meeting.

Discussion continued on recommendation 5.

An amendment was offered by Mark Miller that the word increase be changed to the word adjustment. After discussion the motion was DEFEATED.

An amendment was offered by David Setzer that the wording on recommendation 5 be changed to read: "As part of the review the congregation shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation." After further discussion the amendment was ADOPTED by a vote of 43 to 25.

The order of the day prevailed. Following announcements, Presbytery recessed for lunch following the blessing by the host pastor, Alan A. Morrow.

Presbytery re-convened at 1:20 p.m.

The first item of business was continuation of discussion on recommendation 5 as amended. The vote was taken and the Moderator ruled that the motion was ADOPTED by the necessary 2/3 vote.

A motion was made by C. R. Beard and ADOPTED as follows: "That the Stated Clerk/Administrator be asked to compile a single statement to be used by congregations with regard to clergy salary.

The Presbytery then returned to consideration of the 2011 Budget.

With consent of the second, James Barker withdrew his motion regarding IBL.

Mr. Barker then offered the following motion which was ADOPTED:

- 1. That the 2011 budget be adopted.
- 2. That the Outreach Committee be granted permission to petition the Treasurer and the Commitment and Finance Committee for support from sources outside the 2011 budget.

The report of the Committee on Outreach was ADOPTED as follows:

#### REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON OUTREACH

This Committee last met on June 24, 2010, at the Bethel ARP Church in Winnsboro, SC. All committee members were present. Incoming member, Rev. George Busch, was in attendance. Garry Smith was unable to attend.

On this occasion Rev. Neal Mathias and Rick Bradley were recognized for their faithful service since the organization of this committee in 2008.

Our last "retreat" for members of the ministry group was held on May23, 2010. Rev. John Rogers, Edwards Memorial ARP Church, led this retreat. He focused his teaching on our "Form of Government". During this year IBL has received invaluable training from Rev. Scott Moore, Rev. Carlos Bonilla, and Rev. John Rogers.

The summer months slowed us down a bit in our efforts to prepare this ministry group for the future involvement in the work of ministry. Our next retreat is planned for September 25. Rev. Boyce Wilson, Ebenezer ARP Church, will be the leader.

Thieves destroyed the sanctuary A/C. A new unit has been installed at a cost of \$2,500.00. Insurance covered \$2,000.00 and IBL paid the deductible of \$500.00. As many churches have done, a protective cage was installed around this unit at a cost of \$400.00, which was paid for by Catawba Presbytery.

When this Committee was organized in 2008, little did any of us know of the economic down turn that we have now experienced. This situation has affected our work in three ways. 1) This Committee has wrestled with attempting to begin a fund raising effort in this climate. We know we must begin immediately. 2) A need for funds to continue the ministry until the economy will allow us to meet the immediate needs before us. 3) Sale of Gregg Street Property. We have not put it on the market because of the economy.

This Committee needs your support if this ministry is to continue. What can you do?

- 1. Pray for this work.
- 2. Provide funding through presbytery means, special gifts, etc.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Pray daily for this ministry.
