April 11, 2011
7:00 P.M.**

Catawba Presbytery met for a called meeting on April 11, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. at the Union Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church, Richburg, South Carolina. The Moderator, J. Steve Maloney, called the meeting to order and opened with prayer.

Guy H. Smith, Stated Clerk, constituted the roll from the enrollment cards. [APPENDIX A] A quorum was present. Visitors were welcomed.

C. Ronald Beard, Acting Reading Clerk, stated the purposes of the meeting as follows:

1. To examine 2 candidates for calls and membership in the Presbytery.
2. To approve a call from First Columbia for an associate minister and any matters connected with that call if the way is clear.
3. To approve a call from the Committee on Church Extension for an Evangelist for New Church Development in the Dallas, TX area and any matters connected with that call if the way is clear.

Mr. Beard announced that the Memorial from the First Lancaster Church had been withdrawn at the request of the Session.

The report of the Commission on the Minister and His Work was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK

The Rev. Duff James has responded to a call from First Presbytery to serve as an ARP Church Mission Developer for the Ashville area beginning May 1, 2011. The congregation of First Presbyterian Church of Columbia has concurred with his request to dissolve the pastoral relationship effective April 30, 2011.

The Commission met with the Church Extension Committee and their candidate, Rev. David Winburne who would serve as a Presbytery Evangelist for Church Development in Dallas, TX, effective July 1, 2011. Rev. Winburne is of First Presbytery in good standing.

The Commission met with the First Columbia Associate Pastor Search Committee and their candidate Rev. Derek Thomas who was approved by the congregation to serve as Associate Pastor effective June 1, 2011. Rev. Thomas is a member in good standing with the Mississippi Valley PCA Presbytery.

Recommendations:

1. That David Winburne be examined and if the way be clear, his call to serve as Presbytery Evangelist for Church development be approved and presented to him.
2. That Derek Thomas be examined and if the way be clear, his call to serve as Associate Pastor of First Presbyterian Church of Columbia be approved and presented to him; and that the details of his Sunday June 5, 6 PM Service of Installation be arranged with the chairman of the Commission.

Mr. Lauten examined Mr. Thomas and Mr. Winburne for membership on behalf of the Commission. Following an opportunity for questions from the floor, the examination was sustained. Mr. Thomas will be transferred by the Mississippi Valley Presbytery, PCA effective June 1, 2011. Mr. Winburne will be transferred by First Presbytery effective July 1, 2011.

The call from the Committee on Church Extension for Mr. David Winburne to serve as an Evangelist for New Church Development beginning July 1, 2011 was read and approved with the following terms:

1. Pay you a Total Compensation of \$89,800 which includes
 - a. Base Salary \$40,410
 - b. Housing Allowance \$49,380
 - c. Travel Allowance \$0
2. Pay your ½ your moving expenses {ONA pays ½}
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan Fund as prescribed by the General Synod.
4. Pay 100% of Synod's life, health, and dental insurance for the pastor and his family
5. The Church Extension Committee provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death coverage provided by and as required by the General Synod.
6. One week to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education and pay expenses up to \$1,000 for such continuing education expense.
8. Review with you per our one year agreement. As part of the review the Church Extension Committee shall decide whether to move forward with work in Dallas, TX.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of four weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise: To continue **for a minimum of three months** the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
12. In the event you should die during the terms of this call, we promise: To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for your immediate family **for a minimum of three months.**

The Moderator presented the Call to Mr. Winburne and it was accepted by him.

The call for Mr. Thomas to serve as an Associate at First Columbia beginning June 1, 2011 was read and approved with the following terms:

1. Pay you a Total Compensation of \$150,000 which includes
 - a. Base Salary \$100,000
 - b. Housing Allowance \$45,000
 - c. Travel Allowance \$5,000
2. Pay your moving expenses.
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan Fund as prescribed by the General Synod.
6. Pay 100% of Synod's life, health, and dental insurance for the pastor and his family
7. The Church provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death coverage provided by and as required by the General Synod.
6. One week to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. Two week and expenses for continuing education and pay expenses up to \$1,000 for such continuing education expense.
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base

- compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of four weeks.
 10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
 11. Pay you \$750 per year for ancillary expenses.
 12. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
To continue **for a minimum of three months** the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
 13. In the event you should die during the terms of this call, we promise:
To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for your immediate family **for a minimum of three months.**

The Moderator presented the call to Mr. Thomas and it was accepted.

Mr. Lauten offered prayer for Mr. Thomas and Mr. Winburne and their work.

Announcements were made.

The meeting was adjourned following a closing prayer and benediction by Andrew K. Putnam.

The report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Small and Declining Membership Churches was presented and ADOPTED AS INFORMATION as follows:

REPORT OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE ON SMALL AND DECLINING MEMBERSHIP CHURCHES

Following a directive of Presbytery at the Spring, 2011 Stated Meeting, Moderator Steve Maloney appointed Mike Evans, David Mitchell, David Duncan, Dwight Pearson and Jim McLurkin to serve on this committee.

The stated purpose of the Committee is as follows:

- 1. To study the role of the Presbytery with regard to assisting churches with declining membership;*
- 2. To recommend to the Presbytery concrete ways, including but not limited to financial assistance, with the goal that Presbytery may assist smaller churches in securing leadership that will enable them to continue as a viable ministry.*

An organizational meeting was held at the Sharon Church on April 2 with discussion and input coming from each committee member from their perspective of being involved in a small/declining membership congregation.

Our next meeting has been planned for June 4 at the Hopewell Church where representatives from small or declining membership churches in that area have been invited to share their concerns and offer suggestions as to how Presbytery could be of assistance to them. We also anticipate meeting in other areas of the Presbytery to gain like information to enable us to formulate our final recommendations.

Recommendation:

1. That members of Presbytery, ruling elders and other church members join us in daily prayer as we contemplate Presbytery's ministry to the smaller/declining churches within our bounds.

Information:

The Moderator has appointed Mr. Oliver Johnson of the Bethel Church to succeed Harmon Patrick who is finishing his term. Mr. Johnson will begin serving July 1, 2011. We are grateful to Mr. Patrick for his service on the OBC Commission.
7. The information section for the Rules of Procedure will be added following the June meeting of Presbytery. This timing will allow any additions to be included.
8. Derek W. H. Thomas was installed as Associate Pastor at First Columbia on June 5, 2011. A Commission of the Presbytery conducted the installation. [APPENDX B]

CATAWBA PRESBYTERY COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION REPORT

This has been a busy and productive period for Church Extension since our March meeting.

A few highlights will serve as our report.

First, Andrew Stager began his Residency/Internship in Rock Hill, on April 1. He is meeting at least weekly with the pastoral mentor, Marty Taylor. He is also working throughout the week with John Chambers, his coach. He has a schedule for preaching and teaching in the next several months. He is in the process of creating a vision proposal that will be presented to the churches in Rock Hill, Lancaster, and other Catawba churches in the coming months.

Second, Tim Bowers began his residency on May 1 and is in the process of moving to San Antonio, TX after meeting with the CE chairman, the ONA Director, and his mentor/coach, Jan Sattlem. We expect a progress report at the June meeting.

Third, David Winburne is on schedule to move to the field in Dallas, TX, on July 1. The core group is already forming and planning.

Fourth, the mission work for Grace Presbyterian mission, a work of First Presbyterian in Columbia, is moving forward with the selection of a mission developer. Brandon Barrett will be introduced at the June meeting.

Fifth, the Parenting Church Community in Rock Hill is searching for a mission developer at this time. The groundwork continues on the part of those churches involved along with ONA and GCA consulting.

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON OUTREACH

Since the last meeting of Presbytery, the Outreach Committee has been very busy working on several matters:

In concert with the ARP Center we have pursued the disability retirement of Rev Jose Juan Diaz.

Six area meetings were held in Catawba Presbytery as follows: February 22 – Bethany; February 24 - First Rock Hill; March 3 -First Columbia; March 10 – Effingham; March 15 - First Lancaster; March 17 – Union. Members of IBL gave stirring testimonies at each of these meeting.

This Committee met on April 7 in a regular session.

At this meeting we had in our possession a letter from Assurant Insurance (Employee Benefits) with great news. Final action had been taken on our request for disability retirement for Rev. J. J. Diaz effective May 30, 2011. His first check should be issued on or around June 1, 2011. We give God the praise for this expedient response!

We are in the process of scheduling a joint meeting of the Committee and the leadership of IBL to discuss plans for the future.

Those in attendance at the area meetings caught a glimpse of the commitment, enthusiasm, and spiritual depth of the IBL members. Our sadness is that more members of the Presbytery were not present to see for themselves what has been happening and is continuing to happen within in this group.

To date the we have had several interested parties look over the Gregg Street property but there have not been any offers.

8. Pay 100% of Synod's life, health, and dental insurance for the pastor and his family
9. The Church provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death coverage provided by and as required by the General Synod.
6. One week to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education and pay expenses up to \$1,000 for such continuing education expense.
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the congregation shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of four weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise: To continue **for a minimum of three months** the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
12. In the event you should die during the terms of this call, we promise: To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for your immediate family **for a minimum of three months.**

The Moderator presented the call to Mr. Barrett and it was accepted.

Recommendations 3, 4 and 5 were ADOPTED.

There was no new business.

The Stated Clerk, Guy H. Smith, announced the Fall Meeting for October 11, 2011 at the Bethel Church, Winnsboro, SC beginning at 10:00 a.m.

The Moderator introduced the new Moderator, Bill O. Fleming. Mr. Fleming begins his term July 1, 2011.

Mr. Maloney then introduced the new Vice Moderator, Ruling Elder Michael Evans from the Arsenal Hill Church. Mr. Evans will become moderator on July 1, 2012.

Words of thanks were expressed to the retiring moderator, Steve Maloney, for his faithful and dedicated service during the past year.

The Moderator expressed appreciation for his term and experience as moderator and also expressed appreciation to the Clerks for their work and assistance.

Following the singing of Bible Songs 280, "Christian Unity" Presbytery recessed to adjourn with the adjournment of Synod. R. B. Elliott, III closed the meeting with prayer and benediction. The Presbytery adjourned on Thursday, June 9, 2011 with the meeting of Synod.
