The report of the Stated Clerk/Administrator was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE STATED CLERK/ADMINISTRATOR:

Information:

- The Executive Committee received a request to act in behalf of Presbytery concerning a possible donation of property to the Presbytery. The Executive Committee voted unanimously to approve allowing the trustees of Presbytery to receive the property in Irmo on behalf of Presbytery. The permission is given with the understanding that there are no conditions or strings attached to the gift of the property.
- The Executive Committee received a request from the Clover Session to act in behalf of Presbytery to endorse their plans to building additional education space, renovate some existing areas and add an elevator at a cost of \$787,000. They plan to borrow \$450,000 with the remainder coming from their funds. A contractor is ready to begin on June 1. The Executive Committee voted unanimously to act in behalf of Presbytery and endorsed the plans of the Clover Church.
- The Installation Service for Rev. Bill Fleming as pastor of the Rogers Memorial Church was held in Rock Hill, SC on Sunday, April 17, 2016 at 3:00 p.m. The service was conducted by a Commission of Catawba Presbytery consisting of Teaching Elders Kyle Sims, Chairman, Mark Hering and Gregory Slater along with Ruling Elders Tom Roper {First Rock Hill}, Tony Crenshaw {Oak Ridge} and David Hinson {Neely's Creek}. The report of the Committee on Church Extension was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION

The committee on Church Extension met on May 23, 2016 at Bethel ARP Church for the purpose of reviewing and praying for Presbytery's work of church extension. During the meeting, the committee took action regarding a proposal from Rev. Matt Awtrey, church planting intern in Irmo, SC, and a proposal from Rev. Rob Turner regarding a revitalization/church planting work at Arsenal Hill Presbyterian Church in Columbia, SC.

Proposal for Irmo Presbyterian Mission

The committee received a proposal (which is attached) from Rev. Matt Awtrey regarding Irmo Presbyterian Mission, Associate Reformed Synod in Irmo, SC. Matt has been doing exploratory work in Irmo for the presbytery as a church planting intern since April 2016. The Lord has opened doors for him and his family in the community, and the committee is confident that He will continue to do so. His proposal calls for the following three-year funding plan from four different sources.

The committee unanimously approved the proposal for Irmo Presbyterian Mission and was encouraged by the evidence of the Lord's hand upon the work in Irmo. In addition to approving the proposal, the committee also approved a call to Rev. Matt Awtrey as Mission Developer for Irmo Presbyterian Mission, Associate Reformed Synod. The committee has met with the Commission on Ministers and His Work and received the commission's approval of the call. Presbytery should also note that the Executive Committee of ONA's Board will vote to approve the funding request during a meeting at General Synod.

Proposal for Arsenal Hill Presbytery Mission

The committee received a written request from the Session of Arsenal Hill Presbytery Church to "become a mission church of Catawba Presbytery in order to revitalize and grow for His [Christ's] service in this place [Columbia, SC]." This request will enable the committee to offer financial and leadership assistance to Arsenal Hill as she faithfully seeks revitalization in the grace of Christ. The committee unanimously approved the Session's request.

Along with the above request, the committee received a proposal from Rev. Rob Turner for the church planting and revitalization effort at Arsenal Hill Mission. (The proposal is attached.) Rob has been faithfully ministering alongside of, and working with, the folks at Arsenal Hill since his return from Turkey in August 2015. The committee is encouraged by Rob's diligence and the Session's willingness to endeavor on this revitalization/planting effort. The Lord's hand certainly appears to be in it. Rob's proposal calls for the following three-year funding plan.

The committee unanimously approved the proposal and also approved a call to Rev. Rob Turner as Mission Developer for Arsenal Hill Presbyterian Mission, Associate Reformed Synod. The committee has met with the Commission on Ministers and His Work and received the commission's approval of the call. As with the Irmo Mission, the Executive Committee of ONA's Board will vote to approve the funding request during a meeting at General Synod.

Arsenal Hill Property

Form of Government 3.12 and 3.23 clearly state that title to all property of a local congregation be held by the congregation and that the title to the property be transferred to Presbytery in the event that the congregation ceases to be organized. The committee and the existing Session of Arsenal Hill Presbyterian Church recognizes that the church's property will technically belong to Presbytery if and/or when Presbytery acts to transfer Arsenal Hill from an organized congregation to a mission one. However, the committee is convinced that it is in the best interest of the life and ministry of the mission for all assets, including property, to be held in trust by the Provisional Session of Arsenal Hill Presbyterian Mission (to be named) on behalf of Presbytery. Such an arrangement would not require a change in the deed of the property.

Provisional Session Members

Both of the missions that the committee approved will need provisional sessions. The committee is currently working with Rob and Matt to appoint provisional elders to each of their missions. The committee will submit the appointees for Presbytery's approval at its summer meeting.

Recommendations

1. That the report be received as information.
2. That Presbytery establish Irmo Presbyterian Mission, Associate Reformed Synod as a mission of Catawba Presbytery according to the terms of the attached proposal.
3. That Presbytery issue a call to Rev. Matt Awtrey as Mission Developer for Irmo Presbyterian Mission, Associate Reformed Synod if the way is clear.
4. That Presbytery grant Arsenal Hill Presbyterian Church mission status.
5. That Presbytery approve the revitalization/church planting plan for Arsenal Hill Mission, Associate Reformed Synod as submitted by Rev. Rob Turner.
6. That Presbytery issue a call to Rev. Rob Turner as Mission Developer for Arsenal Hill Presbyterian Mission, Associate Reformed Synod if the way is clear.
7. That Presbytery allow the Provisional Session of Arsenal Hill Mission, Associate Reformed Synod to hold title to the property of the former Arsenal Hill Presbyterian Church in trust on behalf of the Presbytery.
8. That the total expenses of Catawba Presbytery's Committee on Church Extension's 2016 budget be raised to \$115,000 so as to account for the increase in startup costs connected to the two mission works approved above.
9. That the Provisional Session for Arsenal Hill be composed of Mike Evans and Bob Taylor from Arsenal Hill and Paul Holcomb and Dan Hoover from Grace, and Ali Mitchell from Crossings Community.

10. That the Committee on Church Extension be allowed to appoint a provisional session for Irmo and report at the October meeting.

IBL continues to grow and thrive as a church plant in Catawba Presbytery. It baptized four and gained six new members on Easter. They are financially and numerically stable and are poised for growth under the right leadership. They are actively seeking to become a particular church in the near future. They are training elders and continue to learn the details of being an ARP church. Please continue to pray for them as they become the model for an ARP presence in the Latin/International community and become a vital part of our denomination's future.

The report of the Commission on the Old Brick Church was presented and RECEIVED AS INFORMATION as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF OLD BRICK CHURCH (OBC)

The Commission met on one occasion, 19 February 2016, since its last report to Presbytery. The Commission has scheduled its next meeting for 12 May 2016 at OBC in Fairfield County.

Items:

The Commission agreed to move forward in preparation to host a special worship service at OBC on Reformation Sunday, 30 October 2016. Since the inception of the Commission in March 2007, the Commission has sponsored a special service in October every 3 years (2007, 2010, and 2013). Initial program coordination has secured the following leadership for the service: Catawba Presbytery Moderator-Elect Allen Broyles, Tirezah A.R.P. Church, York; Dr. Derek Thomas, First Presbyterian Church, Columbia; Mr. David Hodges, First Presbyterian Church, Columbia; and the Centennial A.R.P. Church choir, Columbia. Much logistical planning and preparation lies ahead.

The Commission approved a plan to paint the church building's interior, all the exterior trim and shutters, and the metal railings and gates. The plan calls for the painting to be done in

late summer in preparation for October's service. Two decades have passed since the interior was last painted.

The Commission scheduled its annual spring grounds maintenance and clean-up for Thursday, 12 May 2016. This will consist of trimming shrubs, applying round-out to unwanted growth, and removing debris from the area inside the wall which includes the graveyard. Outside the wall, work will focus upon dead-fall removal and bush-hogging the areas used for parking during our services. The first hour of the 12 May gathering will be devoted to Commission business and serve as our quarterly meeting.

At the 19 February meeting Mr. Matthew Fletcher of Fletcher Monuments in West Columbia, South Carolina, gave the Commission a progress report on the gravestone repair and stabilization project that began in 2014. Through 13 February 2016, 37 monuments have received attention with first priority of work on monuments that might endanger humans and secondary priority on monuments that might hazard themselves or other monuments. The Commission requested that Mr. Fletcher submit a proposal for continued work on the project for calendar year 2016 with a cap of \$4,500. The proposal should be received in time for consideration at the Commission's 12 May meeting.

REPORT OF THE CATAWBA PRESBYTERY COMMISSION ON MINISTER & HIS WORK

The Commission met on April 11, 2016 at First Rock Hill ARPC. The Commission interviewed Rev. Matt Awtrey for transfer from Second Presbytery to Catawba Presbytery.

The following have been appointed as interim moderators for the following churches: Kyle Sims (Neely's Creek), Andy Putnam (Clover) and Andy Nix (First Hardeeville).

Recommendation

1. That Matt Awtrey be presented at the June meeting of Catawba Presbytery for a transfer exam from Second Presbytery (ARPC) to Catawba Presbytery and if the way be clear, that he be received as a member of Catawba Presbytery.
2. That the call for Bill Fleming as pastor of Rogers Memorial ARPC as approved by the Commission be read for information.

The Call from Rogers Memorial Church for Billy O. Fleming was approved as follows with the terms to begin April 1, 2016 as follows

1. When a housing allowance is provided it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide:
 - 1) Basic Compensation: \$43,000
 - a. Base Salary \$30,000
 - b. Housing Allowance \$10,000
 - c. Travel Allowance – \$3,000
2. Pay your moving expenses
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Pastor waives medical and dental coverage under Synod's group policy for himself and his dependents who are covered under the spouse's group policy.
5. The Church provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death Coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.

6. One weeks to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the Board shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
12. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON MINISTER AND HIS WORK SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

The Commission on Minister and His Work was requested by the session of the Arsenal Hill ARP Church to mediate an impasse that the session had reached concerning the future direction of Arsenal Hill ARP Church. The Commission met with the session and interim moderator David Lauten on Tuesday, March 22, 2016 at 6 p.m. and interviewed the session. After hearing from the session of the two different directions being proposed, the Commission believed it was necessary to meet with the other parties involved before making a recommendation to the session.

On Tuesday, March 29, 2016 the Commission met with and interviewed Rob Turner at 6 p.m. At 7:30 p.m. the Commission met with and interviewed the pastor of Columbia Presbyterian Church (PCA) and two elders from CPC. The Commission also heard a report with regard to input from the chairman of the Church Extension Committee of Catawba Presbytery.

The Commission then deliberated as to what they would recommend to the session. The unanimous recommendation is as follows:

That Arsenal Hill ARP Church petition Church Extension to go on mission status with representation on the provisional session from the Arsenal Hill ARP Church in order to pursue the request of Rob Turner to pursue a multi-cultural ministry.

The Commission met with the session of the Arsenal Hill ARP Church on Monday, April 25, 2016 at 6 p.m. and reported to the session the above recommendation. The Chairman of the Commission on Minister and His Work received correspondence from the Clerk of Session of Arsenal Hill thanking the Commission on behalf of the session for meeting with them to mediate the impasse. In the communication received by the Chairman of the Commission on May 3, 2016, it was reported that the session had voted to concur with the Commission's recommendation. Further, it was stated that the session was calling a congregational meeting for Sunday, May 22, 2016 after the morning worship service to bring the recommendation before the congregation for their approval. The session requested that the Chairman of the Minister and His Work Commission be present as an observer. The Chairman attended the congregational meeting on May 22, 2016 at which time the congregation voted to concur with the Commission's recommendation.

The Commission on Minister and His Work met on Thursday, May 12, 2016 at First Rock Hill ARP Church at 6 p.m.

The Commission examined Matt Joldersma for transfer from Florida Presbytery to Catawba Presbytery and went over the terms of call from the Neely's Creek ARP Church to him. The Commission met with the Pulpit Committee from Neely's Creek.

Jonathan Williams of the Clover ARP Church and Evan Frazier of Hill City ARP Church were interviewed as to coming under care as students of theology.

Watson Gunderson was examined for licensure. A request from Evan English to labor outside the bounds of Presbytery was considered.

The Commission on Minister and His Work met on Monday, May 23, 2016 at 7 p.m. at Bethel ARP Church, Winnsboro, SC.

The Commission interviewed Rob Turner for transfer exam from Second Presbytery to Catawba Presbytery. The Commission met with the Church Extension Committee to go over the terms of call for Matt Awtrey and Rob Turner as mission developers.

Recommendations:

1. That Matthew J. Joldersma be presented to the Presbytery for transfer from Florida Presbytery to Catawba Presbytery and if the way be clear that he be enrolled as a member of Catawba Presbytery effective June 7, 2016.
2. That the terms of call for Matthew J. Joldersma as pastor of Neely's Creek ARP Church be presented to Presbytery for approval and if the way be clear that the call be presented to him at the meeting of Catawba Presbytery on June 7, 2016.
3. That Jonathan Williams and Evan Frazier be presented to the Presbytery to come under care of Presbytery and if the way be clear that their names be added to the list of theological students under care of Catawba Presbytery.
4. That Watson Gunderson be presented to the Presbytery for licensure and ordination exam and if the way be clear that he be enrolled as a licentiate of Catawba Presbytery.
5. That Evan English be granted permission to labor outside the bounds beginning May 12, 2016 until March 31, 2017.
6. That Rob Turner is presented to the Presbytery for transfer exam from Second Presbytery to Catawba Presbytery and if the way be clear that he be enrolled as a member of Catawba Presbytery effective June 7, 2016.
7. That the terms of call for Rob Turner as mission developer of Arsenal Hill ARP mission be presented to the Presbytery for approval and if the way be clear that the call be presented to him at the meeting of Catawba Presbytery on June 7, 2016.
8. That the terms of call for Matt Awtrey as mission developer of Irmo ARP mission be presented to the Presbytery for approval and if the way be clear that the call be presented to him at the meeting of Catawba Presbytery on June 7, 2016.

- 11. Other: Six months of sabbatical leave every 7 years
- 12. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - i. X To continue **for a minimum of three months** the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
 - ii. X If you are residing in the manse, and during the month following the terms outlined in "i" above, to assist you in relocating and to contribute **a minimum of up to one month's base salary** toward your relocation expenses.
- 13. In the event you should die during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - i. X To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for your immediate family **for a minimum of three months**.
 - ii. X If you are residing in the manse, and during the month following the term outlined in "i" above, to assist your immediate family in relocating and/or contribute **a minimum of up to one month's base salary** toward these relocation expenses.

The call from the Committee on Church Extension for Matthew Awtrey to serve as the Irmo Mission Developer was read and approved with terms to begin July 1, 2016 as follows

Robert D. Turner, a former member of our Presbytery, was examined and received by transfer from Second Presbytery effective June 7, 2016.

The call from the Committee on Church Extension for Robert D. Turner to serve as Mission Developer for Arsenal Hill was read and approved with the following terms to begin August 1, 2016 as follows:

1. When a housing allowance is provided it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide:
 - 1) Basic Compensation: \$60,000
 - a. Base Salary \$42,500
 - b. Housing Allowance \$15,000
 - c. Travel Allowance – \$2,500
2. Pay your moving expenses
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Provide Synod's life, health and dental insurance package for the Pastor and his family.
5. The Church Extension Committee provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death Coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.
6. One week to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the Board shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
12. In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

Kyle Sims, a member of the Commission, examined Watson M. Gunderson for licensure and/or ordination. After an opportunity for questions from the Presbytery, the examination was sustained

The Moderator asked the questions for licensure from the Form of Government. All questions were answered in the affirmative. Mr. Gunderson was presented a Certificate of Licensure. Mt. Sims offered prayer for Mr. Gunderson.

John Rogers, Chairman of the Commission, introduced Jonathan Williams, a member of the Clover Church, and Evan Frazier, a member of the Hill City Church, to be received as students of theology. Mr. Williams and Mr. Frazier gave a brief synopsis of their faith journeys. The Moderator then conducted the Service of Recognition for them and Daniel Wells offered prayer. The Moderator instructed that their names be added as students of theology.

All recommendations of the Commission were ADOPTED.

John Rogers announced that Robert Turner would serve as Moderator of the Arsenal Hill Provisional Session beginning June 7, 2016.

In new business a recommendation from the Committee on Committee and Finance was presented and ADOPTED as follows: The Committee recommends that up to \$5,000 be taken from the General Fund of Presbytery for painting the Old Brick Church's interior {walls, ceiling, doors}, all exterior trim {window, fascia}, shutters, both iron gates and the iron railings on the steps in preparation for the triennial worship service to be held October 30, 2016.

There was no other new business.

Stated Clerk/Administrator Guy H. Smith announced the fall meeting for October 11, 2016 at the First Lancaster Church.

The Moderator then introduced the new Moderator Alan J. Broyles from the Tirzah Church. Mr. Broyles will begin his service July 1, 2016.'

The Moderator also introduced the new Vice Moderator/Moderator-elect L. Charles Hammond.

Following announcements and the singing of Bible Songs #280, the meeting recessed to adjourn with the meeting of the Synod. Moderator Alan A. Morrow offered prayer and pronounced the benediction. Presbytery adjourned with the Synod on Thursday morning, June 9, 2016.
