- Granted honorable retirement to Tony R. Grant effective July 1, 2014
- Dissolved the pastoral relationship with Jonatan Simons and the Clover Church effective July 31, 2014 so that he may pursue advanced theological studies
- Heard the sermon of Joshua A. Squires, approved his examination for licensure and ordination and licensed him to preach
- Examined Calvin W. Todd and received him by transfer from Tennessee Alabama Presbytery
