PRESBYTERY NEWS

The following news is reported from the recent stated meeting of Presbytery:

Presbytery adopted a motion to close the Pleasant Hill Church on November 6, 2011 or earlier if necessary. The report also gave thanks to God for the faithful ministry through the years by this congregation. The Presbytery extended through its Committee on Church Extension two calls for Evangelists for Church Development....one to Andy Stages for a new work in the Rock Hill area and one to Timothy Bowers for a new work in the San Antonia area. Tim was also received into the Presbytery. Presbytery also gave approved to an exploratory work in the Dallas area.
