REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON COMMITMENT AND FINANCE

Presbytery Assessment:

The Presbytery assessment for 2020 will be \$15.00 per communicant member. The \$15 will be disbursed as \$11.00 for Church Extension, \$3.50 for Presbytery operations, and \$.50 for the Old Brick Church for 1 more year as approved earlier by Presbytery.

Reminder:

The Presbytery Assessment is based on the figure reported by each session in the annual Statistical Report to Synod as of December 31st and recorded in the current Minutes of Synod under the statistical tables. It is this report of the Church's communicant membership that is used to calculate the Presbytery Assessment.

Denominational Ministry Fund:

The Committee receives a summary of the annual Statistical Reports and has oversight of the Denominational Ministry Fund in the Presbytery. The summary for the giving to the Denominational Ministry Fund is as follows:

REPORT OF THE CHRISTIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The Catawba Presbytery Christian Education Committee met on August 22, 2022 at Edgemoor ARP Church. The following is a summary of that meeting.

Reports from Spring Events

- The Middle School Retreat was held March 25-27, 2022 at Bonclarken. There were 118 attendees. Rev. Clint Davis was the speaker with a focus on the Gospel of John. Chris Holder led the worship.
- The Senior High Retreat was held March 4-6 at Bonclarken, in conjunction with First, Second, and Grace Presbyteries. Rev. Evan English was the speaker. The Casons led the worship. There were 340 in attendance.
- The Catawba Presbytery Senior Day was held March 18, 2022 at First Columbia. Dr. Iain Duguid was the keynote speaker. He spoke twice: "Living Your Best Life Now- And Forever" from Psalm 1 and "Telling the Old, Old Story to the New Generation" from Psalm 78:1-8. Judy Doudoukjian provided the piano music. Breakout sessions included: Medicare 101 with Crystal Strong from the S.C. Department on Aging and "First Presbyterian Churchyard Tour: Active in Church and State" with Mr. Tom Gotshall. There were about 130 in attendance.

Upcoming Events

- The Middle School Retreat will be November 4-6, 2022 at Bonclarken. The speaker has not yet been finalized, but it will be either Keith Ginn or Josh Helmick. Worship Leader is also not finalized, but it will be Chris Holder, Hunter Tomlin, or Will Milks. Seminars will be presented by Adam McKinney, Hamilton Patrick, Josh Starnes, and either Hunter Tomlin or Josh Helmick. Even though the speaker and the worship leader have not been finalized, the committee approved the speaker and worship leader from the proposed names because they are known and/or have previously served at other retreats. The committee approved the retreat.
- The Senior High Retreat will be September 23-25, 2022 at Bonclarken. Jim Wilkerson of Mission to the World will be the speaker. The Cason's are tentatively set as worship leaders. Eric Lockemy and Ben Alexander will present seminars. The committee approved the retreat.
- The inaugural Young Adults Retreat will be September 30-October 2, 2022 at Bonclarken. Rev. Clint Davis will be the speaker and Dustin Ashenfelder will be the worship leader. Bob Elliott and Eric Lockemy will present seminars. The committee previously approved this retreat at the committee's January 2022 meeting.
- The next Children's Retreat will be scheduled for the spring of 2023. The committee will have more information at the spring meeting of presbytery.

Discussion was held concerning added responsibilities that may fall upon the CE Committee now that CEM has been dissolved. At the final board meeting of CEM in December, this question was posed, and, while no definitive answer was given, the apparent answer was that these responsibilities would seem to fall upon the individual presbyteries. Therefore, the committee determined that there was need to develop and distribute a brief survey to all churches in Catawba Presbytery to ascertain their use and/or need of Christian Education resources (apart from *The Quarterly*) since these resources are

no longer available through CEM. The committee voted to develop and disburse a questionnaire to the churches in Catawba Presbytery to discern the CE needs in Catawba Presbytery (i.e.- small group resources, children's ministry, discipleship, etc...). A CE meeting via Zoom was called for August 30 to develop this brief questionnaire. The questionnaire is to be distributed by October 11, preferably sooner. The committee requests that the churches fill out and submit the questionnaire no later than November 21, 2022.

2. That Presbytery encourage all churches to fill out and submit the questionnaire by Nov. 21, 2022.
3. That Presbytery pause to pray for the upcoming retreats of Catawba Presbytery.

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION

The Committee on Church Extension met once since the summer meeting of Presbytery: August 15, 2022. We met at Rowan ARPC in Lugoff at 6:30 pm.

Our meeting was opened with prayer and a brief devotional by the Rev. Watson Gunderson.

We met a final time with Josh Smith for our last update on Kings Church. Josh Smith provided us with the activities that he and his provisional session had been doing over the summer as well as additional details regarding the upcoming organizational service for Kings Church and Josh's ordination. Josh Smith also thanked the committee for their support and prayers all of the previous years. We closed our meeting with Josh Smith with prayer and praise for Kings Church and his hard work.

Rev. Gunderson also read an e-mail update from Rev. Justin Brickey and his pending relationship as a mission developer with IBL. Rev. Brickey expressed his concern for support from the Presbytery for him in this move to combine his work with World Witness and Outreach North America. Rev. Gunderson did verify with Minister and His Work that there is support for this move pending the approval from the World Witness Board. Rev. Brickey stated that this issue should be on the agenda for the October meeting of World Witness.

Rev. Gunderson closed the meeting with prayer.

Recommendations:

2. That the Presbytery pause for prayer for our church plants and our church revitalization efforts.

Motion was made and approved to grant Wayne Frazier, Outreach North America, Church Strengthening Coach the privilege of the floor in order to update the Presbytery on his work with ONA. Rev. Justin Brickey of IBL provided an update on the work there.

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK – SHEPHERDING

The Commission met with Josh Smith and the pulpit committee of King's Church concerning particularizing King's Church and for the purpose of calling Mr. Smith to be their full time pastor. The Commission approved the request for Mr. Smith's call contingent upon King's Church particularizing, and fulfilling all other requirements concerning that movement. The resignation of Rev. Steve Woods of Faith Fellowship Church in Texas was received by the Commission August 21, 2022. Because of the financial hardship of salaries, the congregation approved the request of Faith Fellowship. Mr. Woods will become the stated supply for the present time.

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON MINISTER/HIS WORK – CANDIDATES AND CREDENTIALS

The Credentials Commission On The M&HW appreciates your prayers and support in doing the work the Lord has called us to do. We have two new members, Rev. Mark Miller and Mr. Steve Maloney, as well as a new chairman, Rev. Jon Oliphant. Our commission met on September 1st and dealt with a number of items to report.

- We met with Josh Fleming and Evan Frazier and examined them as to their desire to come under care of the Presbytery. Each man came under the care of their local session (First Columbia and Neelys Creek respectively) and their sessions recommended them to us. Both men shared their testimony and sense of call to gospel ministry. The commission voted to recommend both men to come under the care of presbytery.
- We finalized the agenda for the called meeting of presbytery on September 13th. Five students will preach their middler sermon (Mark Donald, Ryan Gladden, Nate Cesky, Daniel Mick and Gavin Hodges).
- Two students, Andrew George and Mark Donald, took their middler exam.

- With the addition of two new members to the commission we revised our student oversight list.
- The licensure exam rewrite was put on the backburner due to transition in our commission. However, we are taking this work back up and hope to have it finalized by the end of the year.
- We discussed our desire to change a procedural aspect of our floor exams for licensure. Given the sensitive nature of this vote, we are now going to ask the student and any family members to leave the room while the court discusses and votes on their licensure. This will allow the court to speak openly about candidates.
