Permission was granted so that the cemetery would be a separate entity from the Church.

#### REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

#### **Past Events:**

- Fall High School Retreat The retreat was held at Bonclarken on September 23-25, 2016. The theme was The Offices of Christ with the Rev. Dr. Alexander Campbell (Christ Reformed Church) as the speaker. Will Milks led the music. 342 youth and adults attended the retreat.
- Fall Middle School Retreat The retreat was held at Bonclarken on October 28-30, 2016. First and second presbyteries participated in this retreat. The speaker was Dr. Mark Ross and the theme was Sanctification vs. Legalism. Will Milks led the music.
- Children's Retreat The retreat was held at Neely's Creek ARP Church on Saturday, October 8, 2016. The theme was based on Psalm 19:1-2 "The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork." Joy Feemster and Margaret Kiser will led the teaching. Music was provided by the 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade after school club from Neely's Creek. 80 children and adults attended the retreat. This was lower than expected, but the attendance was affected by Hurricane Matthew.

#### **Future Events:**

- 2017 High School SPRING retreat (Mar 3-5): Paul Patrick (RUF Campus minister / Chaplain of Erskine College) will be the keynote speaker. Will Milks will lead the music. First and Second Presbyteries will be participating participate.
- 2017 Middle School SPRING retreat (Mar 24-26): Garison Taylor will be the keynote speaker and Will Milks will lead the music.
- 2017 Children's Retreat (November at Neely's Creek ARP): The exact date and details are a work in process.
- Theological Foundations Weekend: The original plan was to have this weekend in February. Scheduling conflicts and other factors forced us to postpone this event and perhaps change the format to a one-day seminar rather than a weekend. Plans are still a work in progress.

In addition to receiving the reports from Presbytery's missions, the Committee took up two other item of business. The first was a communication from the provisional session of River Crossing Mission requesting that Presbytery close the mission on March 31, 2017. With heavy hearts, the Committee unanimously approved the request.

The second item was a communication from the session of Hill City Church requesting that the Committee "discern whether Kirk Irwin should be extended a call as an Evangelist to do gospel ministry among the artist population in the York County region." Kirk is a member of the congregation and has served on staff with CRU (formerly Campus Crusade for Christ) for 25 years. The Committee approved the request in concept and will begin to work with the Commission on Ministers and His Work to determine whether such a call is possible within the bounds of the Form of Government and Rules of Procedure. The Committee is not prepared to make a specific recommendation regarding Mr. Irwin at Presbytery's spring meeting.

#### **Recommendations:**

- 1. That Presbytery receive the committee's report as information.
- 2. That Presbytery approve the request from the provisional session of River Crossing to close the mission effective March 31, 2017.
- 3. That Presbytery pause for prayer on behalf of David and Emily Stover as well as the members of the River Crossing core group.

- 5. The Clerk of the Provisional Session will be asked to turn over the session records to the Stated Clerk of Presbytery. Later the records will be deposited with the ARP Archives.
- 6. The Clerk of the Provisional Session will also be asked to provide to the Presbytery Stated Clerk a list of the communicant members that remain on the roll of the mission at time of closing.
- 7. The transfer of membership of those remaining members will be done on request by a letter to the Stated Clerk of Presbytery.

The report of the Commission on the Old Brick Church was presented and RECEIVED AS INFORMATION as follows:

#### REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE OLD BRICK CHURCH

The Commission met on one occasion, 22 September 2016, and coordinated the conduct of its fourth triennial worship service at the OBC since its last report to Presbytery. The Commission has scheduled its next meeting for 9 February 2017 at Bethel ARP Church in Winnsboro.

#### **Items:**

The 22 September 2016 meeting centered itself upon the final planning and preparation for the Sunday, 30 October 2016, triennial worship service which took place at the OBC in western Fairfield County at 3 pm that afternoon. The service drew around 150 persons and glorified God through the faithful preaching of His Word, and by the praising of His name through beautiful music. Moderator of Catawba Presbytery, Mr. Alan Broyles, welcomed all; Rev. James McManus, Bethel ARP Winnsboro, presided; Dr. Derek Thomas, First Presbyterian Columbia, preached the Word; Mr. David Hodges, First Presbyterian Columbia, gave an historical perspective; and the Centennial ARP Church choir and its Precentor, Mrs. Judy Doudoukjian, led the music. This service honored our Lord and brought us ARPs and other believers together for a great time of fellowship, while also serving to remind us of our blessed heritage of religious freedom bequeathed to us by our forefathers.

The Commission continued the gravestone cleaning and preservation effort through the employment of Fletcher Monuments of West Columbia, South Carolina. Last fall, prior to the triennial worship service, work focused on cleaning monuments and preserving some box tombs in the west area of the graveyard. Preservation work will continue in 2017 as the Commission in its upcoming meeting on 9 February 2017 will consider a proposal of work from Fletcher Monuments to be completed this calendar year.

Additionally, a second major area of interest for the Commission at its February meeting concerns the 160 year-old granite wall which circumscribes the graveyard. Both tree roots and ground pressure are negatively affecting the wall's stability, especially the south-side section of the wall. The Commission has consulted with several contractors on options to ameliorate the problem. Those options will be examined by the Commission to decide on a corrective course of action.

### REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON STATE OF THE CHURCH

The Committee has met once since the last stated meeting of Presbytery and is actively exploring how we might better fulfill some of our duties, but the Committee has no recommendations to submit at this time

The report of the Commission on the Minister and His Report was presented as follows:

### REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK

The Commission on Minister and His Work has met 3 times since the October 2016 meeting of Presbytery. The Commission met on Thursday, November 17, 2016 at Edgemoor ARP Church, on Monday, December 5, 2016 at Living Waters ARP Church and on Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at Centennial ARP Church.

The Commission received notification of and approved the retirement of Alan Morrow from Bethany ARP Church effective January 31, 2017. Jose Portillo Gamero's name was removed without censure as a student of theology under care of Catawba Presbytery because he has joined

a PCA church. Andrew Di Iulio requested to be transferred as a student of theology under care of Catawba Presbytery to Second Presbytery was so granted contingent upon his joining Greenville ARP Church and being received as a student by Second Presbytery. Mr. Di Iulio has accepted the position of Director of Student Ministries at Greenville ARP Church beginning January 1, 2017.

Requests to labor outside the bounds were received and reviewed. Proposed supply agreements were received and reviewed. Requests from licentiates Brad Anderson and David Huffman were received and reviewed. Vacant churches were assigned interim moderators. They are: Garison Taylor (Clover ARP Church), Mel Wines (Living Waters ARP Church), Philip Bunch (Bethany ARP Church) and Alan Morrow (co-moderator of Hickory Grove/Smyrna).

The Commission met with Martin Taylor (minister) and the session of Living Waters ARP Church at their December 5, 2016 meeting concerning the financial condition of the church. The Commission received a request from the session that the pastoral relationship be dissolved. Mr. Taylor was in agreement with this request. The Commission received and approved the request that the pastoral relationship of Martin Taylor with Living Waters ARP Church be dissolved effective December 31, 2016. Terms of a transition package were discussed and agreed upon by Mr. Taylor and the session.

The Commission has also been in contact with the Provisional Session of New Hope ARP Church. They are currently forming a cemetery association which is separate from the church but under the provisional session's authority. The Commission strongly urges that churches with cemeteries but do not have such a cemetery association to form one.

As part of the Commission's report, the following reports are provided:

<u>Vacant Churches</u>: At the present time the Presbytery has 15 Vacant Churches, with 6 actively searching for a new Pastor. The Vacant Churches and their Moderators are: Bethany ARP Church, Active Search Committee, Philip Bunch, Moderator Blacksburg ARP Church, Active Search Committee, Jim Klukow, Moderator; Centennial ARP Church, Active Search Committee, Calvin Todd, Moderator; Clover ARP Church, Active Search Committee, Garison Taylor, Moderator; Faith Presbyterian Church (Sumter), Non-Active Search Committee, Scott Moore, Moderator; Hardeeville First, Non-Active Search, Andy Nix, Moderator; Hopewell, Active Search Committee, Dwight Pearson, Moderator; IBL, Non-Active Search Committee, Scott Moore, Moderator; Lemira Presbyterian Church, Non-Active Search Committee, Brian Peake, Moderator; Living Waters ARP Church, Non-Active Search Committee; Alan A. Morrow, Moderator; New Hope, Non-Active Search Committee, Clyde McCants, Moderator; Smyrna and Hickory Grove, Active Search Committee, Boyce Wilson/Alan Morrow, Co-Moderator; Westminster ARP Church, Non-Active Search Committee, Rev. Brian Howard, Moderator; White Oak ARP Church, Non-Active Search Committee, Rev. Clyde McCants, Moderator; York ARP Church, Active Search Committee, Barry Eller, Moderator.

<u>Licentiates</u>: Brad Anderson is director of Youth Ministry at First Presbyterian Church of Columbia; David Huffman is open to a call; and Joseph Crump is open to a call.

- 8. That the mission developer's call between David Stover and Catawba Presbytery's Church Extension Committee be dissolved effective March 31, 2017 and that he be listed as laboring outside the bounds as of that date.
- 9. That the salary reviews are found to be in order be received as information.

The meeting re-convened at 1:15 p.m. and heard a presentation by William Woods, a representative of Trail Life. Mr. Woods spoke briefly about Trail Life and its goals.

Presbytery then returned to the Report of the Commission on the Minister and His Work.

Recommendations 2-9 were read and ADOPTED.

The Stated Clerk made a motion to dissolve the Ad Hoc Committee on Small Churches due to the fact that the needs of the small churches are so varied. The motion was ADOPTED.

The report of the Committee on State of the Church on Session Records was received and ADOPTED as follows:

#### REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE STATE OF THE CHURCH

The Committee met the day of Presbytery to examine session records from churches whose names begin with the letters A – H along with the records of: **IBL**, **Neely's Creek**, **New Hope**, **River Crossing**, **Rogers Memorial**, **Scots Kirk**, **and Westminster** who did not bring records to the last meeting.

After examining the records according to the guidelines from the Rules of Procedure, the Committee makes the following recommendations:

- 1. That the records of the following churches be approved without exception: Arsenal Hill, Bethany, Bethel, Centennial, Chester, Clover, Crossings Community, Edgemoor, Edwards Memorial, Effingham, Faith, First Columbia, First Hardeeville, Good Shepherd, Hickory Grove, Hopewell, Neely's Creek.
- 2. That the records of the following churches be approved with minor exceptions: Calhoun, Ebenezer, Faith Fellowship, Grace, Irmo Mission, Rogers Memorial, River Crossing, Scots Kirk, Westminster
- 3. That the records of the following churches not be approved: NONE
- 4. That the following churches who did not bring session records to this meeting be reminded to bring the records to the Fall meeting: Blacksburg, Hill City, Hope LA, Hope -TX, IBL, New Hope,
- 5. As a result of an earlier decision by the Committee, we sent out a survey to the 16 missionaries and chaplains who are part of Catawba Presbytery desiring to improve communication with them and awareness of how to pray for them. So far we have received 5 responses including 3 surveys. We are including part of that information here in our report:

LTC Peter Johnson (USA) in Baghdad, Iraq, wrote – Pray for wisdom while preaching, counseling and talking with Service Members. Pray also that there would be a revival for renewed faith in Christ among our military men and women;

Andy Stager in Korea wrote – Please pray that our contribution to our local church would be fruitful. I've been installed as an associate pastor, and we both have a ministry to younger believers (mostly foreigners/expats living in Seoul) that we want to be effective without draining us too badly. You can also pray that our children will continue to thrive here in Korea, and that their hearts will grow more tender toward the Lord.

Mark Witte in Toledo, Spain, wrote – Please pray: For my family, pray for God to continue to strengthen our faith; For God to use us and our ministries to call others to saving faith; For the church plant, that more families and individuals will commit to it and for Sunday morning and evening weekly worship to begin this May; For the church plant to grow and be constituted as a church, and thus also form a presbytery with our mother church in Madrid; & For God to provide us with additional help and gospel workers to expand the outreach and ministry of the church plant, and for God to continue to provide for all of our needs and the needs of the church.

#### 6. Other Recommendations:

In order to better facilitate communication between our presbyters, specifically with our missionaries and chaplains, the State of the Church Committee wishes to create a <u>closed</u> (invitation only) Facebook Page for presbyters of Catawba Presbytery for edification and communication of prayers, praises, struggles, and joys.

The Committee also desires to go on the record to clarify for our Sessions that we do not consider 3-ring binders a "permanent binding" as required by the guidelines in our Rules of Procedure.

#### CHARLES LUMMUS MITCHELL December 2, 1922 – December 7, 2016

Charles Lummus Mitchell was born on December 2, 1922, a son of George Franklin and Ethel Orr Williams Mitchell of Edgemoor, S.C. He grew up in the Edgemoor ARP Church. His early education was in Edgemoor, where he completed high school.

In 1940 he entered Erskine College and following his freshman year he joined the Army Air Corps from which he was honorably discharged in 1946. He received a BA degree from Erskine College in 1948 and a BD degree from Erskine Theological Seminary in 1951.

He was ordained to the Gospel ministry in 1951 and served as pastor of four ARP churches: Old Providence (Va.), Fayetteville (Tenn.), Crowders Creek (N.C.), and Covenant (N.C.). He retired in 1987 after 37 years of ministry, but then for the next 23 years he served as Minister of Visitation for Ebenezer ARP Church, Rock Hill, SC. In recognition of his faithful years of ministry, Erskine Theological Seminary conferred upon him the Doctor of Divinity degree in 2009.

In the Synod he served on the Boards of Erskine College, Dunlap Orphanage, and Stewardship and on the Committees of Finance and Nominations. In Virginia and Tennessee-Alabama Presbyteries he was Moderator. In First Presbytery he served a Vice Moderator, stated clerk, and treasurer. It should be noted that he attended 68 consecutive meetings of the ARP General Synod.

He is survived by his wife of 67 years and faithful partner in ministry, Mary Alice Moore Mitchell. Other survivors include one brother and four sisters. He is also survived by two daughters: Maryethel Bowers and Cheryl Stone. A son, George E. Mitchell, preceded him in death. There are four grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

Charles Mitchell was a faithful preacher of the Word of God and a caring pastor to his flocks. He was well liked by all ages. He had a great sense of humor and always had a joke, a riddle, or a story to tell. He will be missed by all who knew and loved him.
