Catawba Presbytery met for its Stated Meeting at Shiloh Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church, Lancaster, SC on March 10, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. Moderator Gregory C. Stated Clerk/Administrator Guy H. Smith constituted the roll from the enrollment cards. A quorum was present. [APPENDIX A] Visitors were encouraged to register. Visitors were then recognized by Moderator Slater.

Mrs. Susan Lever, Editor of the ARP Magazine, was introduced. Mrs. Tanner spoke about her work and encouraged those present to subscribe to the magazine to be informed about the work of Synod. She also spoke about Denominational Ministry and its importance. Other denominational ministries were also mentioned.

Unfinished business was considered.

Changes to the Rules of Procedure placed on the docket from the October 8, 2019 were presented. The changes proposed are recorded in the Minutes of Presbytery, 2019-2020, Volume 1, page 10 and following. A motion was made and ADOPTED that the proposed changes be approved.

A report of the Ad Hoc Committee to Close First Hardeeville was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE FOR DISSOLVING FIRST ARPC OF HARDEEVILLE

The Ad Hoc Committee for dissolving First ARPC of Hardeeville met on Monday, March 2, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. at Centennial ARP Church in Columbia, South Carolina. The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer.

By way of background on the work of this committee, the authority for making a decision as to the dissolution of a congregation rests with the Presbytery within which the congregation is located. [FOG 3.21, 3.22] There are no further procedural guidelines for dissolving a congregation contained in The Form of Government. Catawba Presbytery's Rules of Procedure provide in Article X, Section I, the affirmation that the Presbytery has the authority for a decision to dissolve a congregation. Article X, Section II goes on to provide for the procedure to be followed in dissolving a congregation. However, all of Section II is predicated upon the fact that there remains a remnant of the congregation which is to be dissolved. In this particular case, the only members attending First ARPC of Hardeeville are the members of one family. Additionally, there is only one ruling elder within the congregation. It is impossible to comply with Section II of Article X as there are an insufficient number

of members of a Session to call a meeting and therefore Catawba Presbytery in its prior meeting, declared First ARPC of Hardeeville to be closed and appointed the within Ad Hoc Committee.

The Chairman reported that he had met with the Clerk of Session of Hardeeville, Everett Proctor, the sole remaining elder in the church. He has obtained the keys to the church, the sessional records of the church, contact information for utility providers, landscape providers and insurers to provide for an orderly transition for the payment of these expenses to be borne by the Catawba Presbytery.

The Chairman also reported that the church is adjacent to property owned by the City of Hardeeville and is utilized as parking for the recreation department for the city. The Chairman spoke with the town manager of Hardeeville and he has expressed great interest in purchasing the property. The Chairman has requested a quote from Randy Waite, a certified appraiser who had recently appraised the property and may be engaged to update this appraisal for use in establishing the current fair market value of this property.

The Committee also requested, pursuant to Article X, Section III of the Rules of Procedure, that the Stated Clerk of Presbytery assist any members of the congregation who desire to transfer their letters to another church.

As it is likely that an offer to purchase the property will be received from the City of Hardeeville prior to the next meeting of Presbytery, a motion was made, seconded and duly approved to request that Presbytery grant Commission authority to the Committee in order to effectuate a sale of the property. Further, the deed, closing statement and any related documents would be executed by the Moderator of Catawba Presbytery and attested to by the Stated Clerk of Catawba Presbytery.

The Committee also requested prayer for the remaining members of the congregation and for the work of this committee seeking to obtain the highest and best value for the property. The motion was approved.

The meeting was closed with prayer.

Recommendations:

1. That the Presbytery receive this report as information.
2. That Presbytery grant Commission status to this Committee to negotiate the sale of the church property of First ARPC of Hardeeville seeking the highest and best value for the property, with the deed, closing statement and any and all other related documents be executed by the Moderator of Catawba Presbytery and attested to by the Stated Clerk of Catawba Presbytery.
3. That Presbytery pause and pray for the members of the congregation and for the process of negotiating the sale of the church property.

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

The Catawba Presbytery Christian Education Committee met on Monday, January 27, 2020 at Edgemoor ARP Church, Edgemoor, S.C. The following is a summary of that meeting.

Reports of past events:

Fall High School Super Retreat - September 20-22, 2019

The retreat was held at Bonclarken. This retreat is a joint effort between Catawba, First and Second Presbyteries. The theme for the weekend was *The Life of David* using several different Psalms. The speaker was Sam Cotten (World Witness Missionary). The music was led by the RUF team from Anderson University. There were 357 participants including students and leaders. Mr. Josh Valentine (Neely's Creek ARP Youth Director) served as our director.

Fall Middle School Retreat - November 8-10, 2019

The retreat was held at Bonclarken. The speaker was Rev. Dean Franklin (Shiloh ARP Church). The theme was from *Psalms 121*. The music was led by Brandon Auten and the worship team from Crossings Community ARP. There were 225 participants from 15 congregations including staff, students and leaders. Mr. Josh Madsen (First Pres., Columbia) served as our director and Rev. Jeremiah Thomas (Centennial ARP Church) served as our assistant director.

Reports of planned events:

Spring High School Super Retreat - March 6-8, 2020

The retreat will be held at Bonclarken. This retreat is a joint effort between Catawba, First and Second Presbyteries. The joint committee to plan had not completed their work at the time of our meeting. Mr. Josh Valentine (Neely's Creek ARP Youth) serves as our director.

Senior Adult Day - March 13

This one day event will be held at First Pres., Columbia, SC from 9:00-2:30 and lunch will be provided. The theme for the day is: *Finishing Strong: How the Gospel Enriches our Later Years*. The speaker will be Dr. Dale Ralph Davis. Special music will be provided by Dan and Holly Cole. A selection of seminars will be offered. Rev. Stephen Jordan (Rowan ARP Church) serves as our director and Rev. Bryan Bult (First Pres., Columbia) is serving as assistant director.

Spring Middle School Retreat - March 27-29, 2020

Area Youth Leaders Fellowship Dinners

The Committee is attempting to host a supper and opportunity for fellowship in several of the presbytery's larger geographic areas. REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION

The Committee first met with Rev. After dismissing the contingent from King's Church, the Committee discussed this matter and moved to table discussion. A conference call with Rev. Awtrey, Mr. Smith and the church treasurer will be scheduled to discuss this matter more.

The Committee then considered the following request from Montage ARP, "In accordance with FOG 9.8, change the Rev. Leon M. Brown's call to evangelist with option to eventually seek other employment to supplement income." After discussion, the following motions were made:

- to change Rev. Leon M. Brown's call to evangelist with option to seek other employment to supplement income. This was approved.
- to continue our agreed upon and approved financial support of \$100,000 over 4 Years.

This was approved.

The Committee also considered the recommendation from the King's Church session to approve Mr. Larry Stokes to serve on the provisional session. Mr. Stokes is an ordained elder from Centennial ARP. This was approved.

The meeting was closed with prayer.

Presbytery heard updates from the Mission Developers on their work. Presbytery also heard from Wayne Frazier from ONA on programs available to assist local churches in various areas including revitalization.

Clint Davis offered prayer for the Mission Developers and their work.

The Report of the Commission on the Old Brick Church was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON OLD BRICK CHURCH (OBC)

The Commission met once, 11 September '19, since its last report to Presbytery. The meeting convened at the OBC in western Fairfield County, South Carolina. The Commission has scheduled its next meeting for 12 February '20, at the OBC.

Items:

11 September 2019 Meeting – The Commission used the September meeting to complete planning for the 27 October '19 worship service conducted at the OBC. The Commission reviewed the tasking document delineating each commissioner's responsibilities and identified any outstanding needs. The generator and sound system needs found solution, while the driveway and drainage ditches were approved for maintenance prior to October's worship service. Additionally, the Commission approved the 2020 gravestone preservation work. Following the conclusion of the business, the commissioners conducted yard maintenance and grounds clean-up both inside and outside the graveyard wall. The exterior areas were bush-hogged, cleaned of heavy debris, and readied to accommodate parking. The interior yard received necessary shrubbery trimming, and weed-eating and spraying. This supplemented the outstanding grounds care Mr. John Swearingen of Bethel ARPC in Winnsboro provides throughout the year.

Driveway & Drainage Ditch Work – The driveway and associated ditches exhibited a need for repair, especially in light of the upcoming October worship service. In early September the Commission secured the service of the S. C. Department of Transportation who did the driveway repair at no charge. Willingham Landscape and Asphalt placed “rip-rap” in the drainage ditches to correct the ditch-erosion problem.

October Worship Service at the OBC – The Commission hosted a worship service at the OBC on Reformation Sunday, 27 October '19, at 3 pm. A wonderful time of worship and fellowship was enjoyed by a full church with more under the tents. Rev. Greg Slater, current Moderator of Catawba Presbytery presided and preached the Word. His sermon entitled, “Our New Identity in Christ,” was based upon 1 Peter 2: 4 – 12. His message both challenged us in our Christian walk and reminded us of the sacrifice of our lineage from the Scottish Reformation. Mr. Bryan McKown, former OBC Commission Secretary, gave an historical reflection on the Colonial times and families in the Fairfield District when the OBC was built. The Centennial ARP Church choir led the music under the leadership of its director, Mrs. Judy Doudoukjian. The order of worship had as its Psalm of Praise: Psalm 148, “Hallelujah, Praise Jehovah.” Following the service, the ladies of White Oak ARP and Bethel ARP provided delicious refreshments for all to enjoy during an extended time of fellowship!

Clinton Presbyterian Home – A small group of seniors led by Rev. Jim Caprell, Chaplain of the Clinton Presbyterian Home, visited the OBC on 20 November '19. The visit served as an outing for the seniors and included lunch in Winnsboro before returning to Clinton. An OBC Commission member greeted the group at the church and provided them an historical briefing about the OBC and the ARP denomination. After the briefing the group toured the building and the graveyard. There was one ARP in the group, and all voiced appreciation for the visit.

Burials – After 15 years with none, we experienced two burials in 2019, Mrs. Juanita D. Goff on 8 February, and Mr. James P. Macfie on 13 May. Mr. Macfie's brother, Dr. Rice Macfie, is currently under hospice care. The Macfie family plot has been appropriately prepared.

Commission Changes – The new calendar year brought personnel change to the Commission. Mr. Cal McMeekin, First Presbyterian Church Columbia, and Mr. Larry Whitesides, Chester ARP Church, left the Commission. Both Cal and Larry rendered dedicated, professional service to the Commission and to Catawba Presbytery with a combined tenure of nearly 17 years of care for our historic house of worship. Mr. Rick Bradley, Centennial ARP Church, and Mr. Bob Harkins, White Oak ARP Church, have answered the call and begun serving 3-year terms. They will be officially welcomed at the Commission's 12 February '20 meeting.

Presbytery recessed for lunch provided by the Shiloh Church at 12:15 p.m. The blessing was offered by Jonathan Oliphant. Presbytery re-convened at 1:15 p.m.

L. Charles Hammond introduced Mr. Joshua D. Adair to preach his Middler Sermon. Mr. Adair read as his scripture John 3:22-36. The Moderator thanked him for his message.

Dr. R. Leslie Holmes, Moderator of Synod, brought greetings from Synod. Mr. Homes emphasized the importance of worship, work and witness. He spoke also of the high calling of a pastor and the role of local elders.

Mr. David Pendergrass, representative from Erskine College, spoke briefly. He spoke of the spirit for good on the Erskine Campus and how God is working on the Campus and in lives of students.

The Report of the Commission was presented as follow:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK

Our meetings in latter October 2019 through January 2020 have mainly consisted of working through the situation concerning Rev. Dariusz Brycko in Poland. As had been stated in the October meeting of Presbytery, Mr. Brycko had resigned from World Witness effective September 2019. That meant that he was resigning from the pastorate of the church in Poland at the same time as well. It was agreed upon by World Witness and Mr. Brycko that he would be paid until December 31, 2019. The Commission began to meet to determine the best course for the future in order to keep Mr. Brycko in Catawba Presbytery, as, by his request, he is under the care of our Presbytery. There had been some concerns from people in the Polish congregation as well as from the steering committee of the Polish Church that ultimately led to Mr. Brycko's resignation from World Witness. To that end, others who had been consulting with Mr. Brycko on the work in Poland from here in the United States, the Toile Lege Institute Board, the World Witness Executive Board, as well as another respected missionary in Western Europe who knew the work in Poland and Mr. Brycko as well expressed similar concerns. We have also heard from some of the former members from the church in Poland as well. We were tasked to attempt to help Mr. Brycko in some form of counseling process in hopes of seeking reconciliation between, hopefully all parties that had been harmed spiritually or emotionally. There was no physical situation, let it be known.

After careful analysis through interviewing and seeking guidance from many of the injured parties as well as from parties in defense of Mr. Brycko, then from Mr. Brycko and his wife, as well as seeking assistance from an expert, Dr. Don Fairbairn, the culture of the Slavic area, we issued the

recommendation to have Mr. Brycko begin counseling with a counselor of his choice and with our approval. We also have recommended entering into a process with Peacekeepers Ministries in order to create a time of reconciliation with various parties. We are sensitive to the costs of travel, etc. so we are limiting his travel time to the United States as much as we can. We are seeking financial assistance for him in costs incurred already and for future travel expenses. Mr. Brycko is complying with our recommendation and the program will be overseen by the Commission until the process has been completed and reconciliation for as many as want it, will be achieved. At this time Dariusz is working as an English translation teacher at a school in Poland. He has been given our permission to translate and coordinate seminars, etc. at Toile Lege Institute. At this point, we feel it best that he not pursue any activities concerning pastoral or shepherding responsibilities until such time that we deem appropriate. Again he is complying with the recommendation. Finally the Commission on the Minister and His Work will continue to monitor his work outside the bounds of Presbytery with ongoing periodic reports. Our goal is to see Dariusz Brycko restored to full ministerial functions. Please pray for this work in the future.

In our January 7, 2020 meeting at the Union Church in Richburg, the Commission interviewed Daniel Mick to come under care of Presbytery as a student of Theology.

At a meeting in Columbia on January 28, 2020, a decision was reached as to the concerns of a member of First Presbyterian Church of Columbia. The Minister and His Work Commission will attempt to speak with the session of First Presbyterian Church of Columbia concerning actions that need to be taken to settle the dispute.

The Commission did meet with the FPC Committee Thursday, February 11 to discuss potential options for them to move forward in the situation concerning a member of FPC. They are making recommendations that will have to be approved by the Session of FPC as soon as is possible as to how to proceed with the matter. Much has been done and they are moving forward.

Recommendations:

- 1 That Daniel B. Mick be presented to come under care of Presbytery as a student of theology and if the way be clear that his name be entered on the roll of students of theology of Catawba Presbytery. Ok.

- 2 That the following requests to labor outside the bounds be approved: Mark Hering, James L. Klukow, Mark I. McDowell, David Stover, Scott Moore, Dariusz Brycko, Russ Harless, Jon Simon.
- 3 The Commission reviewed and approved the following supply agreements and recommends approval: Hickory Grove ARPC [Alan Morrow and Boyce Wilson]; Hill City ARPC, Buzzy Elder, Moderator; Hopewell ARPC [Dwight Pearson and David Setzer], Lemira ARPC, [Dan Rowton], New Hope ARPC [Mark Hering], Sherwood Forest [Russ Harless]; Smyrna ARPC [Alan Morrow and Boyce Wilson], White Oak [Clyde McCants], note that with Dr. McCants' failing health the agreement between White Oak and Dr. McCants is null and void.
- 4 That Catawba Presbytery allot a financial package to assist in expenses concerning Dariusz Brycko at the pleasure of the court.
