Information:

- The Committee on Nominations reported as authorized by Presbytery they had chosen Norman Kent to fill the vacancy on the Committee on Church Extension.
- The Service of Installation for Bryan Bult as associate at First Columbia was conducted April 15, 2018. The Commission consisted of Teaching Elders David Lauten, Chairman, Kyle Sims, Derek Thomas, Gabe Fluhrer and Josh Squires along with Ruling Elders Robert Alexander {First Rock Hill}, Dan Felker {Centennial} and Tom Ryan {First Columbia}. - George P. Busch, Jr., a member of our Presbytery since November 25, 2005 and pastor of the Scots Kirk Church, Summerville, SC died April 24, 2018. The Report of the Executive Committee was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The 2019 meeting of Synod is scheduled to be held in Pennsylvania near the Pittsburgh area. Many details are still to be determined....housing other than dorms and how far from the meeting site they will be....meals and where they will be.....places to meet, etc. The recent survey indicated that a quorum said they would be present for Synod but not by a large number.

One suggestion made was that Presbyteries may wish to consider re-scheduling their meetings at an earlier time to avoid both Presbytery and Synod having to be concerned with a quorum.

Further our Presbytery requires churches as part of the call to pay the expenses of pastors to Presbytery and Synod. Since calls in our Presbytery state the expenses to the meeting of Synod for the pastor are covered by the church, it is possible many of our smaller churches may not be able to afford paying for the pastor and elder to attend because of the added expense and distance involved. It makes it more probable that a Presbytery quorum may possibly be an issue.

One of the duties of our Executive Committee is to handle matters on rescheduling meetings of Presbytery. We felt it necessary in this instance to reconsider the time of our June 2019 meeting and possibly re-schedule it to an early earlier time. By handling this matter now the new date would be included on Synod's calendar for 2019. This would also alleviate a concern for a quorum that far away.

The Executive Committee after consideration unanimously recommends the following:

1. That the 2019 June meeting of Presbytery be re-scheduled for an earlier date.
2. That the Executive Committee be authorized to work out the details and location and that we consider maintaining a two hour meeting time at a central location.

The revised Report of the Committee on Church Extension was presented and ADOPTED as follows:

REVISED REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CHURCH EXTENSION

The Committee on Church Extension met on Monday, April 16th at Bethel ARP Church in Winnsboro, SC. The Committee met with Mr. Josh Smith and to discuss the calls of Rev. Leon Brown and Rev. Scott Andes.

First, the Committee met with Mr. Josh Smith, who is with Rev. Matt Awtrey at King's Church in Irmo and will be coming under care of Catawba Presbytery. Rev. Awtrey recommended Mr. Smith to our Committee for consideration to participate in the next CPAC (Church Planting Assessment Center) when it is offered by ONA at Bonclarken. After meeting with Mr. Smith and hearing his testimony, call to ministry and desire to plant an ARP church, the Committee unanimously recommended that he be able to attend to the next CPAC and for the Committee to cover his travel expenses.

The Committee then considered the call for Rev. Leon Brown and his work with the Montage ARP church in Los Angeles, California. After discussion, the Committee approved for the call for Rev. Leon Brown to be recommended to the Minister and His Work Commission and to Presbytery for approval at the summer Presbytery meeting.

The Committee also discussed a new call for Rev. Scott Andes and his campus ministry with Reformed University Fellowship International at the University of South Carolina. After discussion and an update on his fundraising for the ministry, the Committee approved the call for Rev. Scott Andes to be recommended to the Minister and His Work Commission and to Presbytery for approval at the summer presbytery meeting.

The Committee also approved giving funds up to \$10,000 to Rev. Andes and his work at USC.

Recommendations:

1. That the name of the mission in Los Angeles be Montage ARP Mission
2. That Presbytery call Rev. Leon M. Brown as mission developer for the Montage Church in Los Angeles, California.
3. That Presbytery approve the call for Rev. Scott Andes for his work as campus minister with Reformed University Fellowship International at the University of South Carolina
4. That Presbytery pause for prayer on behalf of our church planters and their works:
 - Ben Carver and Charlie Phillips – Shem Creek, Mt. Pleasant
 - Rob Turner – Arsenal Hall, Columbia
 - Matt Awtrey – King's Church, Irmo
 - Leon Brown – Montage ARP
 - Scott Andes – RUF-I at USC

James McManus offered prayer for the missions and the mission developers.

The Report of the Commission on the Old Brick Church was presented and RECEIVED AS INFORMATION as follows:

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF OLD BRICK CHURCH (OBC)

The Commission met on one occasion, 15 February 2018, since its last report to Presbytery. The Commission has scheduled its next meeting for 10 May 2018 at the OBC in western Fairfield County, South Carolina.

Items:

The gravestone preservation work continues. At its 9 November '17 meeting the Commission approved a proposal from Fletcher Monuments to repair another 11 gravestones in 2018. Most of the work will involve affixing dies to bases, leveling, and cleaning. One marble monolith will need excavation, splint repair, and re-installation. One marble top on a box tomb will get attention. Fletcher Monuments of West Columbia, South Carolina, has targeted the work for the week of 23 – 27 April 2018.

At its 15 February '18 meeting, the Commission continued discussions that will lead to a policy governing burials in the OBC graveyard. We're now just shy of 100 years since the OBC conducted regular services. Consequently, burials over the past century have been a rare occurrence; 52 in the past 100 years and none since the establishment of the OBC Commission in March 2007. Ongoing practice through the years has limited burial to persons who have a direct lineal tie to family interred in the graveyard with an available plot(s). Having received three requests for burial plots in the past 8 months, the Commission felt it prudent to produce a written policy. Two of these recent requests involve parties who are direct lineal descendants of persons interred in the graveyard in existing family plots with available burial space. The Commission approved those two requests. The third request had no direct

lineal tie to the OBC or graveyard, but did involve an A.R.P. Church elder who otherwise had a tangential tie to the OBC. His request was not approved. The draft policy will be reviewed for possible approval by the Commission at its 10 May '18 meeting.

The Commission approved its first policy governing requests for marriage at the OBC on 22 January 2015. In early 2017 the Commission received a request from a prospective groom for a May 2018 wedding at OBC. With a policy in place, the Commission had the necessary guidelines to steer the process in an efficient and effective manner. Working through that first marriage request with the new policy, the Commission found several areas of the policy needing adjustment. At the 15 February '18 meeting the Commission made and approved those changes. The effective date of the revised "Wedding Policy" is 15 February 2018.

The 10 May '18 Commission meeting will convene at 9 am at the OBC in western Fairfield County. After conducting its scheduled business meeting, the Commission will conduct its spring clean-up and grounds maintenance. This effort will focus on killing unwanted growth in and outside the graveyard and along the graveyard wall; removing dead-fall from the grounds; trimming bushes and shrubbery; and bush-hogging the parking areas outside the graveyard.

Recommendation: That this report be received as information.

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK

The Commission on Minister & His Work met on Thursday, May 3, 2018 at First ARPC of Rock Hill. The Commission met with and interviewed pulpit committees and their candidates from Effingham ARPC and York ARPC. Mr. David Huang was examined for licensure and ordination. Mr. Josh Smith and Mr. Ben Alexander were examined as students desiring to come under care. Mr. Jim Eish was removed from the roll of students of theology. Benjamin Glaser was appointed as moderator of the Blacksburg ARPC, Marty Taylor as moderator of the Hope, TX ARPC and Ben Carver as the moderator of the Scots Kirk ARPC. Mr. Leon Brown was examined for transfer from the James River Presbytery of the Presbyterian Church in America to Catawba Presbytery of the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church. The Commission met with members of the Church Extension Committee concerning the call of Mr. Brown as mission developer. The call for Mr. Brown as Mission Developer of the Montage Mission in Los Angeles, CA was reviewed. Supply agreements for Mr. Jim Mitchell with Blacksburg ARPC and Mr. Marty Taylor with Hope (Texas) ARPC were approved. The amended call for Scott Andes as Campus Minister of the Reformed University Fellowship International at the University of South Carolina was reviewed.

Recommendations:

1. That the call for the candidate as Minister of Effingham ARPC be read for approval by the Presbytery and if the way be clear that he be presented this call at his ordination and installation service
2. That the call for the candidate as Minister of York ARPC be read for approval by the Presbytery and if the way be clear that he be presented this call at his ordination and installation service.
3. That Mr. David Huang be examined before the Presbytery for licensure and ordination and if the way be clear that he be presented a Certificate of Licensure.
4. That Mr. Josh Smith be presented to the Presbytery to come under care as a student of theology and if the way be clear that the Moderator conduct the Service of Recognition and his name be entered on the roll of students of theology.
5. That Mr. Ben Alexander be presented to the Presbytery to come under care as a student of theology and if the way be clear that the Moderator conduct the Service of Recognition and his name be added to the roll of students of theology.
6. That Mr. Leon Brown be examined for transfer from the James River Presbytery of the Presbyterian Church in America to Catawba Presbytery of the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church and if the way be clear that he be entered on the roll as a minister in Catawba Presbytery.

7. That the call for Mr. Leon M. Brown as Mission Developer of the Montage ARPC Mission of Los Angeles, CA be read for approval by the Presbytery and if the way be clear that he be presented this call.
8. That the amended call for Scott Andes as Campus Minister of Reformed University Fellowship International at the University of South Carolina be read for approval.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE MINISTER AND HIS WORK

The Commission on the Minister and His Work met on Tuesday, May 15 at 6:00 p.. as the Centennial ARP Church. The Commission met with Brooks Willet for a transfer from Palmetto Presbytery PCA to Catawba Presbytery.

Per request of Craig Wilkes, he was transferred from Catawba Presbytery to Palmetto Presbytery PCA effect on May 11, 2018.

Recommendations:

1. That Brooks Willet be examined for transfer from Palmetto Presbytery to Catawba Presbytery and if the way be clear he be entered on the Presbytery roll pending receipt of his transfer.
2. That the call for Brooks Willet as a Volunteer in Mission from World Witness be read for approval, and if the way be clear that it be presented to him.
3. That Billy Fleming be recognized as honorably retired effective October 31, 2018 and that he be recognized at the October 2018 meeting of Presbytery.
4. That Paul Pepin be recognized as honorably retired as of August 31, 2018 contingent upon the vote of the congregation and that he be recognized at the 2018 October meeting of Presbytery.

The Call from the Effingham Church for Joseph M. Crump as Pastor was approved by the Commission with the terms to begin June 24, 2018 follows

1. When a housing allowance is provided it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide:
 - 1) Basic Compensation: \$65,000
 - a. Base Salary \$41,500
 - b. Housing Allowance \$21,000
 - c. Travel Allowance – \$2,500
2. Pay your moving expenses
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Provide Synod's life, and health and dental insurance package for the pastor and his family.
5. The Church provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death Coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.
6. Two weeks annually to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education.
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the Church shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.

- 12 In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

Recommendation 2 was ADOPTED

The Call from the York Church for M. Jordan Bernard as Pastor was approved by the Commission with the terms to begin July 1, 2018 follows

1. When a housing allowance is provided it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide:
 - 1) Basic Compensation: \$41,000
 - a. Base Salary \$21,000
 - b. Housing Allowance \$18,000
 - c. Travel Allowance – \$2,000
2. Pay your moving expenses
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Insurance – Pastor waives medical and/or dental covered under Synod's group policy for himself and his dependents who are covered under the spouse's group policy.
5. The Church provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death Coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.
6. Two weeks annually to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education.
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the Church shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
- 13 In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

Recommendation 3 was ADOPTED

David Huang was examined for licensure and ordination by Kyle Sims, a member of the Commission. The examination was APPROVED. The Moderator asked the questions for licensure and all were answered in the affirmative. A Certificate of Licensure was given to Mr. Huang.

Recommendation 4 and 5 were ADOPTED

Mr. Joshua D. Smith and Mr. Ben N. Alexander were introduced as new students of theology. Each gave brief explanation of their faith journey. The Moderator conducted the Service of Recognition for Students and instructed that their names be added to the roll of students. 'The Moderator offered prayer for them.

Recommendation 6 and Recommendation 1 of the Supplemental Report were ADOPTED.

Commission Chairman John Rogers examined Mr. Brown and Mr. Willet for transfers from other Presbyterian presbyteries. The examinations were APPROVED pending receipt of their transfers.

The calls for Mr. Brown and Mr. Willet were read, APPROVED and presented to them,

The Call from the Committee on Church Extension for Leon Brown as Mission Developer of the Montage Mission approved with the terms to begin October 29, 2018 as follows

1. When a housing allowance is provided it may be divided to the best interest of the minister and shall provide:
 - 1) Basic Compensation: \$165,000
 - a. Base Salary \$72,000
 - b. Housing Allowance \$84,000
 - c. Travel Allowance – \$9,500
2. Pay your moving expenses
3. Pay into the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Retirement Plan as prescribed by the Synod.
4. Provide Synod's life, and health and dental insurance package for the pastor and his family.
5. The Church Extension Committee provides the cost of Life, Long Term Disability and Accidental Death Coverage as provided by and required by the General Synod.
6. Four weeks annually to be away for evangelistic or other church related meetings.
7. One week and expenses for continuing education.
8. Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation. As part of the review the Church shall be encouraged to consider an increase to the previous year's base compensation.
9. Grant you an annual vacation of 4 weeks.
10. Expenses for the meeting of General Synod.
11. In the event of total disability, as defined in the Synod's insurance program, we promise:
 - a. To continue for a minimum of three months the provisions of this call awaiting commencement of benefits from Synod's insurance program.
- 12/ In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

Note: The mission developer is responsible to raise 100% of the funds necessary to fulfill the provisions of this call. All funds will be collected, receipted and disbursed through the office of the Treasurer of Catawba Presbytery.

The Call from the Board of World Witness for Brooks D. Willet as a Volunteer Missionary {VIM} was approved effective June 6, 2018 with the following terms:

- There is no financial obligation [which includes no benefit package] on the part of World Witness.
- Brooks will be permitted to request reimbursements for ministry expenses {travel, etc.} incurred in doing ministry on behalf of World Witness, if he is able to raise the funds to cover them.
- His ministry will involve partnering, as much as possible with Arsenal Hill Presbyterian Church, Columbia, SC, and working principally with Mr. Ali Mitchell of World Witness.
- His focus will consist of the following:
 - Outreach to refugees through the ESL program
 - Host and periodically lead monthly prayer meetings for outreach to Muslims
 - Preach occasionally and administer the Sacraments.

Recommendation 8 was ADOPTED

The Call from the Committee on Church Extension for Scott Andes as Campus Minister of the Reformed University Fellowship for International Students at the University of South Carolina was approved with the terms to begin June 5 2018 as follows

- 13 In the event of death during the terms of this call, we promise:
 - a. To continue the provisions of this call dealing with annual salary, housing, and group insurance for a minimum of three months.

Note: The Campus Minister is responsible to raise 100% of the funds necessary to fulfill the provisions of this call as well as those necessary to support the Campus Ministry in total. All funds will be collected, receipted, and disbursed through the office of Central Services of the General Synod of the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church.

Recommendation 3 and 4 were ADOPTED.

APPENDIX B

TRIBUTE FOR REV. GEORGE POWELL BUSCH, JR.

Rev. George Powell Busch Jr. was born in Columbia, SC and raised in a Christian home. The son of a Methodist minister, George grew up attending church and believed he was a good Christian man. However, as a freshman at Clemson University, George heard and responded to the Gospel of Jesus Christ for the first time. During a worship service, he was convicted of sin and realized he was a helpless sinner needing a perfect Savior.

Not long after his conversion, George sensed the Holy Spirit calling him to pastoral ministry and he answered the Triune God's call on his life. He graduated from Clemson University (1976) with a B.A. in Secondary Education and then pursued a Master of Divinity from Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson, MS.

His first pastoral call came in the small Lowcountry shrimping town of McClellanville, SC. As a single pastor organizing a mission church, his ministerial work was challenging and demanding. But in the midst of his labors for God's Kingdom, God demonstrated his goodness and mercy to him. At an oyster roast in Charleston, God directed George's steps in the path of a young woman named Brenda Glick. In 1986, George and Brenda were married and began serving the Lord together at Bullock Creek Presbyterian Church in Sharon, SC.

Rev. Busch served the Lord faithfully in the Presbyterian Church of America for 27 years. He diligently served pastorates in Sharon, SC, Winnsboro, SC, and in Abbeville, SC. The past 11 years George faithfully ministered in the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church as minister of Scots Kirk Presbyterian Church in Summerville, SC.

George was committed to shepherding the sheep under his spiritual care. He loved his people. He prayed for his people. He disciplined his people. Because of his faithfulness and care as a pastor, the people under his ministry loved him back. They knew he cared for them and ministered to them in order to “present everyone mature in Christ” (Colossians 1.28).

Moreover, George loved the pulpit ministry. He enjoyed studying and learning God’s Word and preached the truth of Scripture with conviction and compassion. In a time when more and more pastors waiver in faithfully preaching God’s Word, George valued the Bible and faithfully preached the whole counsel of God through his pulpit ministry.

On Tuesday, April 24, Rev. George Powell Busch, Jr. entered the presence of the Lord. He is survived by his wife of thirty-two years, his five children, and six grandchildren. Rev. Busch treasured the Word of God and now enjoys the truth of Psalm 84: “How lovely is your dwelling place, O Lord of hosts! Blessed are those who dwell in your house, ever singing your praise!”
