Job Description for Volunteer Missionary to Malawi

At present, the Church of Central Africa Presbyterian (CCAP) denomination is no longer considered to be biblical in their doctrinal teaching, nor faithfully confessional. Thus there is an urgent need and desire to build and organize a biblical and confessionally faithful Presbyterian church in Malawi.

Confex Makhallira is currently an ordained minister in the PCA and a missionary candidate for church planting in Malawi with Mission To The World. His credentials and accountability is with MTW and the Great Lakes Presbytery of the PCA.

The Expected Commitment:

The time for the Canadian missionary spent in Malawi will be on a part-time/volunteer basis. The period and duration of the stay will be determined by CPM in consultation with the missionary.

The Mission Need in Malawi:

1. Theological Teaching

- The missionary's role will be to focus on pastoral and practical theology.
- The missionary's role will also include mentoring pastors. He will work alongside local ministers and church planters to provide any help, coaching or mentoring that is needed by the pastors, elders and possible church planters.

2. Education and leadership training work

- teaching
- discipling
- personal one-on-one leadership training with Malawian pastors, church planters, elders, or deacons

Christian Witness

Missionaries who labour in theological and leadership training are to remember and do their work in agreement with the Canadian Presbytery's purpose for theological and leadership training in Malawi. Those purposes are:

1. To be an example of a faithful Christian leader as set forth in the CPM Policy Manual
2. To faithfully teach the whole of the Scriptures and the confessional doctrines of the Reformed Faith as expressed in the Westminster Standards as accepted by the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church.
 - a) The courses must exemplify biblical faithfulness, confessional integrity, academic excellence and purposefully promote the spiritual growth of the students.
 - b) All courses taught and/or developed by the missionary must be approved by the Canadian Presbytery, by the CPM committee in conjunction with the Minister & His Work committee.
3. To faithfully assist in the training of Malawian nationals for church leadership and church planting in Malawi:
 - a) The instruction must give Malawian men the understanding of Presbyterian polity, the "how to" of evangelism and discipleship, and a heart & mind burdened to serve and pray for the church.
 - b) If the missionary is an ordained minister he is required to fulfill all the duties of a missionary in accordance with the CPM "Policy Manual" (5.1.1 & 6.1), the Canadian Presbytery Manual of Procedure (Art. 4.b), and the ARP "Form of Government," (FoG 9.9.A).

The Accountability Structure for Malawi Missionary Service

If a candidate has been accepted to labour as a missionary by the CPM (and has been approved by the Canadian Presbytery), he or she is under the jurisdiction of the Canadian Presbytery and is directly accountable to the Canadian Presbytery as provided for in the CPM policy manual.

- a) Prior to each Stated Meeting of the Presbytery, the missionary shall prepare a Report of Mission/Ministry Activities and send this to the Chairman at least one month before the meeting for his use in updating the presbytery.
- b) The CPM committee will request Confex Makhalira (through MTW) to send an annual report reporting on the ministry activities of the volunteer missionary to the CPM chairman at least one month before the spring meeting of the Canadian ARP Presbytery.

Attachment #2 (June 2018)**Covenanters ARP Church of Cambridge****CALL OF A PASTOR**

We, the officers and members of Covenanters Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church of Cambridge, Nova Scotia, being well satisfied with your ministerial qualifications, and confident that we have been led to you by the Holy Spirit as one whose ministry will be profitable to our Spiritual interest, do earnestly call you, Martin Timothy Dendekker, to undertake the office of Pastor of this congregation. On the acceptance of this call, we promise you in the discharge of your duty all proper support, encouragement, and obedience in the Lord. That you may devote yourself wholly to the ministry of the Word, we promise and obligate ourselves to:

- (a) Pay you an annual Salary of \$31,100 in at least monthly payments.
- (b) Provide you with an annual Housing and Utilities Allowance of \$13,200 in at least monthly payments.
- (c) Provide you with an annual Vehicle Allowance of \$4,000 in at least monthly payments.
- (d) Pay your moving expenses.
- (e) Pay \$0.30 per km for all church-related kilometers outside of a 50 km radius of the church, or rental of vehicle.
- (f) Grant you a book/seminar allowance up to \$1,200 annually. Money to be reimbursed once receipts are submitted.
- (g) Pay for you and your dependents' participation in a Health Insurance program to the amount of \$3,000 annually.
- (h) Pay into a Retirement Plan the amount of \$3,000 annually.
- (i) Grant you an annual Vacation Time of four (4) weeks.
- (j) Grant you an annual Study Leave of one (1) week.
- (k) Pay all expenses for Presbytery and Synod meetings.
- (l) Review with you annually the adequacy of this compensation.
