WHO AND WHERE OF MAUPIN

Maupin Avenue Presbyterian Church is a family, growing together in God's Grace and in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Located in the oldest colonial town in the western region of North Carolina, the county seat of Rowan County, Salisbury has a tradition of preserving history and offers a wealth of art and cultural experiences. The city has a dense suburban feel and boasts multiple parks and green areas that nurture a sense of community and promote an active lifestyle. There is a low crime rate in Salisbury and the cost of living here is 10.6% lower than the national average. The population includes a mix of families, young professionals, and retirees. The city is in the Piedmont region, situated between Greensboro and Charlotte, is a hub for education and healthcare, and home to the iconic local brands of Cheerwine and Food Lion. The population is roughly 36K.

Maupin Avenue church was organized in 1926. We sit on a street corner in the Salisbury Historic District, in the Fulton Heights neighborhood. Today we have a total membership of 74 with approximately 50 active members and 20 visitors who regularly attend. Visitors describe our church as friendly and very traditional in worship style and music. We hold Sunday services at 11am, Bible study on Wednesdays at 6:30pm, and we have a monthly prayer breakfast followed by Women's and Men's Ministry meetings.

We desire to be a light in our community, serving our neighbors with the love of Christ and pray that by God's Grace our neighbors not only become our friends, but become part of the family of God.
